AAPI conference in Udaipur



Udaipur: Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare JP Nadda inaugurated the American Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (AAPI) conference and NCD program this week in Udaipur. He said that research by Indian origin doctors in foreign countries and AIIMS doctors will ensure progress of the country in health sector. He said that government and AAPI will work together in this regard. Mr. Nadda inaugurated the conference in American International Institute of Medical Sciences of GBH group in Bedwas of Udaipur.

The minister revealed that seven types of mortality including IMR, MMR, and TFR have reduced by 56 percent. 30 lacs of women and 50 lacs f children have already been vaccinated in India. AAPI is the largest organization of Indian origin doctor in foreign countries. AAPI has more than 10 thousand doctors as members and the organization is being led by Udaipur's Dr. Keerti Jain and Ajay Lodha.

180g stone removed from the bladder of 11 year old girl

Udaipur: Surgeons removed a 180g stone from the bladder of 11 year old girl after a successful operation at Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS) Hospital. Ashish Agrawal, Vice Chairman, PIMS, informed that Salumbar resident 11 year old Bhoolki D/OShankar suffered from stomach ache for a long

Her parents brought her in on 20th December where paediatrician Vivek Parashar examined her. After all examinations, it was revealed that there is a stone in the bladder.

Next day, paediatric surgeon Dr Praveen Jhanwar and his team operated on her and removed a 3.8cm long and 180g stone successfully. The child is now in perfect health. According to paediatrician Dr Vivek Parashar, this has been recorded as the biggest stone removed from the bladder of a child.

New Delhi: Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced a slew of schemes on Saturday evening to herald a prosperous 2017 for the urban and rural poor, farmers, small businessmen, senior citizens, and pregnant women.

Modi started on a sombre note. For the first 23 minutes, he mainly thanked his countrymen for braving the cash crunch, iterated why demonetisation was a necessary weapon in his fight against black money

In his address made to the nation on the very day the demonetisation exercise ended, the Prime Minister did not say much about curbs on withdrawals. operations must return to normal as soon as possible. Then he switched to announcement mode, rattling out enough measures to make his speech sound like a mini-Budget. The first in his list for 2017 were two housing schemes under the Prime Minister Awas Yojana (PMAY). For the urban poor,

home loans up to '9 lakh will get 4% interest exemption. and loans up to `12 lakh will get 3%. In villages, home loans up to '2 lakh will get 3% inter-

est exemption. This would apply not only to loans for building new houses but also those taken for renovating or expanding an existing one. In all, Modi said 33% more homes will be built in rural areas under the PMAY. There was more for the rural poor, who got the lion's share of the announcements. The govt will pay interest for 60 days on loans taken by farmers for Rabi farming from district cooperative banks and societies.

First Training Centre at MPUAT- A training institute could be approved where expert scientists will be benefited with innovative inventions for new age of agriculture. UIT Bridge - This bridge will help locals and tourists alike. This will also help curb the menace of rainy water. The approximate estimate is 3.50 crores of rupees. Court Complex - Zila and session court could be razed to create a fresh complex with more space, facilities for justice system. As many as eight court session will be there and as many as 50 cars and 200 two-wheelers will be parked easily. During construction, court will be shifted to rented premises. Super Specialty Hospital - The idea is to facilitate all the services under one roof. In this age of super-specialty hospitals, government would not like to stay behind of private players. The plan is to construct a six storey hospital in the empty land in front of Janana and Baal Chikitsalaya. Cyber Center MLSU- The Sukhadia University is planning to launch three courses related to Cyber Law. Professor JP Sharma, the VC has constituted a committee to launch Cyber Security, Cyber Management, and Cyber Law courses.
