In the late nineteenth century, the working class was in constant struggle to gain the eight-hour work day. Working conditions were severe and it was quite common to work ten to sixteen hours a day in unsafe conditions. Death and injury were commonplace at many work places and inspired such books as Upton Sinclair's The Jungle and

Jack London's The Iron Heel. The international workers

movement inspired by the industrial workers strike in the United States of America demanded for eight hours of work per day so that the workers can have sufficient time for their personal and

social responsibilities. 300,000 workers in 13,000 businesses across the United States in Unicago, the epicenter for the 8-hour day agitators, 40,000 went out on strike with the anarchists in the forefront of the public's eye. With their fiery speeches and revolutionary ideology of direct action, anarchists and anarchism became respected and embraced by the working people and despised by the capitalists. The leaders were conscious that the peaceful dialogues and petitions might not work against the capitalist classes who cared for nothing but their profits. Therefore they gave slogans like:

Workingmen to Arms! War to the Palace, Peace to the Cottage, and Death

to LUXURIOUS IDLENESS. Wage system is the only cause of the World's misery. It is supported by the rich classes, and to destroy it, they must be either made to work or DIE.
