GITS' students build All-Terrain Vehicle

Udaipur : In gracious presence of Udaipur district collector, an All-Terrain Vehicle was launched in the hands of Gitanjali Institute of Technical Studies last week. The vehicle has been engineered to run on difficult terrains and all kind of roads. With high power in the hands of driver, the co-passengers will also get due comfort. The vehicles was launched by chief guest district collector Rohit Gupta and chairman of Gitanjali group JP Agarwal. The ATV has been prepared by students of second and fourth year students of Mechanical automobile electrical and electronics department. Students who worked to create the vehicle are Yash Wadhvani, Naveen Kumawat, Abi Ali Sabunwala, Dhruv Joshi, Bhanupratap Shaktawat,



Jai Surana, Vishal Nagda, Shubham Agarwal, Lavish Bandwal, Chandraveer Singh, Anuj Menaria, Tanuj Patel, Yaasin Faraaz, Kaushal Lakhara, and Vipul Sanadhya. The ground clearance of 26 cms is good enough to cross many obstacles on the way. Mentors for this projects are Professor Rajiv Mathur, and Professor Vishnu Agarwal, and Dr. Manish Verma. Entire expense of developen the vehicle has been borne by management of Gitanjali. With power and comfort, the ATV is also fitted with embedded password anti-theft system which makes it a safer vehicle.

Tribal women turn engineer- with solar lamps

Udaipur : The army of over 200 women of different self help groups (SHGs) in four clusters of Dungarpur are working under the Rajasthan Gramin Aajeevika Vikas Parishad (Rajeevika), entered into an MoU with IIT-Mumbai for making solar lanterns.

Experts from the IIT imparted technical training to 80 women from Punali, Jhonthari, Biladi and Aantri who in turn are training their peers to make solar lamps at their respective clusters says Vinod Paneri, the district project manager.

IIT has supplied them raw materials, while these ladies are making the lanterns, doing the packaging and marketing

it in remote areas without access to electricity." The task has turn them entrepreneurs of green energy.

Asurvey was conducted by the women to find out the potential of these lanterns and after finding the prospective customers they have embarked on the mission of making 60 thousand lamps" Paneri adds.. This will lead to a turnover of 1.2 crore rupees for the SHGs. The market price of a solar lantern is 500-700 rupees. " If they procure the raw material at their own, these women may sell it at a very competitive price of Rs.200 per lamp and make a profit of Rs.60 per piece" said Sachin Kumar, the project incharge.
