Rajya Sabha Elections Results Declared



New Delhi : The results for 27 Rajya Sabha seats in Uttar Pradesh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Jharkhand, Rajasthan and Haryana that went to polls on Saturday have been declared. BJP has won all the four Rajya Sabha seats in Rajasthan, while Samajwadi Party bagged 7 seats in Uttar Pradesh. In Rajya Sabha elections held on Saturday in seven states to elect 27 members, BJP has won all four seats in Rajasthan. The winning candidates include Union Urban Development Minister M Venkaiya Naidu and Party's National vice president Om prakash Mathur. The other candidates who stood victorious are Harsh Vardhan singh and Ramkumar Verma. In Uttar Pradesh, all the seven candidates of the ruling Samajwadi Party recorded victory. Its candidates Beni Prasad Verma, Reoti Raman Singh, Amar Singh, Sanjay Seth, Vishwambhar Prasad Nishad, Suresh Nagar and Sukhran Singh Yadav were declared victorious in preferential votes. Both candidates of BSP Satish Chand Mishra and Ashok Siddhartha have also won the Rajyasabha seats.Lone BJP candidate Shiv Pratap Shukla also succeeded. Kapil Sibal of Congress defeated Independent candidate Priti Mahapatra. For the lone Rajya Sabha seat in Uttarakhand, Congress candidate Pradeep Tamta defeated BJP supported independent candidate Anil Goyal.The Congress candidate got the support of party's 26 MLAs and 6 MLAs of the PDF. In Jharkhand, Union Minister Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi and Mahesh Poddar of BJP won both the seats. After the win, Naqvi told reporters that by giving both the seats to the BJP, Public Representatives of Jharkhand have strengthened the development agendas of Prime Minister Narendra Modi.In Haryana, BJP candidate Choudhry Birendra Singh and independent Subhash Chandra stood victorious in a high velocity counting. In Karnataka BJP bagged one seat.Party candidate Nirmala Sitharaman got victorious, while Congress won other three seats. 30 candidates were already declared elected unopposed at the end of withdrawal of nominations on June 3. Prominent among them are Union Ministers - Suresh Prabhu and Piyush Goyal, eminent lawyer Ram Jethmalani, Lalu Prasad's daughter Misa Bharati and former JD(U) president Sharad Yadav.

Animesh Bhora Of Udaipur Ranked 19th In IIT-JEE Results

Udaipur: Aman Bansal of Jaipur emerged as the all-India topper in the Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) Advanced-2016, the results for which were announced on Sunday. While From Udaipur Animesh Bhora ranked 19 th .

Two other male candidates from theJaipur - Kunal Goyal (ranked at no 3) and Gaurav Didwania (ranked at no 9) - also figured in the top 10 all-India rankings.

Incidentally, all the three toppers of the examination - Bansal, Goyal and Bhavesh Dhingra (with a ranking of no 2) - were tutored at the Kota-headquartered Allen Career Institute. Kota, a coaching hub in the state, has frequently been in the news over students

committing suicide due to academic stress.

While Bansal and Goyal were coached at the institute's Jaipur centre, Dhingra from Yamuna Nagar in Haryana studied at its Chandigarh branch to make it to top three. The topper among women candidates, Riya Singh (ranked 133), hails from Kota.

Bansal scored 320 marks, while Dhingra and Goyal followed closely with 312 and 310 respectively.

All the three toppers from Jaipur - Bansal, Goyal and Didwania - want to study computer science at IIT-Mumbai.

Bansal, who hails from Vaishali Nagar in the Rajasthan capital, said he never allowed negativity to creep into his mind.

BJP to take fight to opposition

New Delhi: The gloves are off in the fight between the government and the opposition as an aggressive BJP under Prime Minister Narendra Modi and party president Amit Shah is likely to push back hard on every challenge from now.

India's ruling party is excited at the gains it made on Saturday, winning three Rajya Sabha seats beyond its numerical capacity. These victories were the result of defection in rival camps, mostly the Congress that shrank by six seats in the Upper House.

The new-found aggression is expected to reflect on the government's strategy of pushing through key legislation, including the landmark goods and ser-

vices tax bill that has been stuck because of the NDA's lack of numbers in the Upper House.

"Ever since he came to power, Modi tried to build a harmonious relationship with the Opposition. For two full years, the Congress played an obstructionist role.

There is limit to everything. If they are ready for a fight, so are we," a senior BJP functionary said.The BJP won 11 of the 27 Rajya Sabha seats for which polls were held on Saturday, including one extra seat each in Jharkhand and Rajasthan. Subhash Chandra, a BJP-backed independent candidate, defeated the opposition nominee in Haryana after 14 votes were rejected for having used the wrong pen.
