A watch over Hardik Patel's movements



Udaipur: National president of Navnirman Sena and leader of agitation for Patidar agitation Hardik Patel is spending his exile in Udaipur. His temporary stay is in Nakoda Nagar where he is living in the house of former MLA Pushkar Lal Dangri in the Pratap Nagar area.

In view of any agitation or activity that could leave the serene city in any unrest, the administration is vigilant and alert. All the movements of the Patel are being watched and he is in total surveillance. A temporary police picket has been set up in front of the house where he is staying and all his activities are being noted down with close circuit cameras. Along with Udaipur's agencies, the Gujrat IB team is also monitoring his activities.

Last Thursday, Patel's movement to Khemli village in Mavli constituency led the administration to follow him and CIs of four police stations with force reached his house.

Gujrat high court has ordered Hardik Patel to spend six months out of Gujrat and he is staying in Udaipur for his temporary stay and to comply the honorable court's orders.

Patel though described the court order and told police that he can move anywhere out of Gujrat but police refused to step back. Patel's Uncle is reported to have visited him with some court orders. It is being speculated that Hardik might see the police officials to describe his case to them for more convenience in the city.

Udaipur: A PCNS was inaugurated by Padmshree Dr. Ashok Pangadya last week. This facility will help the citizens get all world class treatment facilities for patients fighting with neuro diseases. Pacific center of neuro science is a great achievement and will be a boon for people of the region. The inauguration was done by Padmshree Dr. Ashok Pangadya, BR Agrawal, the chairman of Pacific Group, Dr. DP Agrawal,

the vice Chancellor of the Pacific University, and Dr. Atulabh Vajpayee of the PCNS. "Pacific Center of Neuro Science is the only comprehensive neuro center of Northern India where diseases like stroke can be treated with other world class facilities like neuro surgery, neuro rehabilitation," said Dr. Pangadia. PCNS is a center where neuro facilities are being provided by a team of excellent doctors like Dr. Atulabh Vajpayee, Dr. Narendramal, Dr. Ramakant, Dr. Prashant Singh, Dr. Pankaj Gandhi, and Dr. Teddy. The center is spread in sprawling one lac square feet of area and this will be bene-



fit not only people of the state but it will also be a boon for neighboring states like Gujrat and Madhya Pradesh. Chairman of Pacific Group Dr. BR Agrawal said that PMCH will be first such private hospital of the state where all types of brain related diseases which will not only be reasonable but will also be top notch and world class. Rahul Agrawal, the chair-

man of PMCH apprised that Pacific Center of Neuro Science will have 100 beds of ICU with other necessary facilities like state of the art operation theaters, CT, MRI, Neuro ICU, Stoke Unit, five star private ward, and general and economy wards. Dr. Atulabh Vajpayee on the occasion said that the main aim of the center will be to provide the best medical services to each and every class of the society.

He added that if the patient of stroke is brought to the center within 6-8 hours of stroke, they can be treated by removal of clot through angiography. He revealed that the delay in bringing the patient generally makes the case worse. But he also assured that the center also has facilities for the patients who are brought late after stroke.

No-Vending zone from Court Chauraha to Chetak Circle

Udaipur: First meeting of the Town vending committee was held. The meeting chaired by Sidharth Sihag deliberated on making vending a more organized affair in the city. Mayor Chandra Singh Kothari, said that we intend to organize street vendors so that they can earn their livelihood in an independent and hassle free manner. He said that this re-organization and demarcation of vending zones was not done out of the volition of the municipal council but done at the behest of the Indian Government's street vendor notification dated Feb 15, 2016.

Kirti Rathore, Deputy Commissioner, informed that in the initial phase, first zone comprising of Court Chauraha, MB Hospital, Shiksha Bhawan, Swaroop Sagar, Radaji Chauraha, Rani Road, Rajiv Gandhi Park, Dewali to Fatehsagar overflow, UIT, Mohita Park, Chetak Circle and Bhattiji Bari will be demarcated into vending and no-vending zones.

Dr. Jain returned Website of Aravana Mall launched



Udaipur: Dalmiya Water Awardee 2015, Dr. PC Jain was in the city of Houston, US in the past four months stay. He also met rainwater harvesting expert Mark. Illean and others and presented his presentations regarding the program. USGS and world bank's director with team keenly watched Dr. Jain display the way of rooftop rainwater harvesting with the help of Dewas Water Filters. Dr. Jain along with Mark illean watched and captured photographs on how the rainwater on the roads and rooftops travel its way to the Bio-Ship Channel of Houston and through into the Gulf of Mexico. In the months of June and July Dr. Jain visited many places and worked on rain water harvesting and drugs related problems. In the Sikh centre he also gave a video presentation upon the increasing drug cases in Punjab and urged the people to adopt one drug addict and help him cure the addiction completely. He openly talked about the drug cases of Punjab and also advised the American parents upon how to recognize a drug patient. He also participated in the talk show on YouTube Channel - 'Triple N' with the famous cardiologist Dr. Nikam on 13th June. The talk show can be watched anytime online with the title - 'Addiction among teenagers'. In one gurudwara of the metropolitan city, a presentation was given on the increasing addiction, in which listeners asked questions related to Punjab and one of the women donated 100 dollars to Dr Jain for this noble cause. The largest sewer waste water treatment plant was visited on special permission, where he gained knowledge about the phases of the plant. Udaipur: The newly constructed Aravana business destination mall will be inaugurated on August 26, 2016. The information was divulged by Hasan Paliwal, Director, IKP developers. Website of the mall www.aravanaudaipur.com was launched today in an event by Mrs India United Nations Award winner Dr Priti Solanki Panwar. The website has complete information about the mall including shops, brands, mall timings, csr activities by Aravana etc. Giving out further details on Aravana, Hasan & Paliwal mentioned that the mall will have a rooftop restaurant run by Jaipur based IBC group. Besides, he claimed that the mall will also host the biggest supermarket in the region. Free home delivery will be provided from the supermarket in



the area near the mall. He also mentioned that the mall will host Shiroz hangout cafe that will be run by acid attack victims. He claimed that this would be the first of its kind cafe in Rajasthan. Shabbir Paliwal mentioned that the mall is expected to become a one-stop

destination for tourist's shopping needs. The ground and first floor have been earmarked for national and local brands. Second floor will have handicrafts, mobile accessories, men apparels, leather items and library. Third floor will have queen's

street and will play host to women items. Fourth floor will have multi-cuisine restaurant, kids play area and kids shopping items. Fifth floor will have 20 offices. Sixth and seventh floor will be residential.

3000 saplings planted in Kaladwas

Udaipur: In a tree-plantation campaign organised by Kaladwas Chamber of Commerce and Industries (KCCI), 3000 saplings were planted by 950 volunteers in mere 4 hours. Saplings included varieties like Neem, Gulmoohar, Mango, Tamarind etc. Chaimbar President, Gopal Agarwal informed that 100 NCC cadets, 50 personnel from Army, Seva Mandir and Mahavir International participated in the programme. The volunteers were flagged off
