Health data@ your mobile

Udaipur: Udaipur is set to have all its citizen's health data linked to their mobile number. As a result of this initiative all the past health information will be available at the click of a button at Government or private clinics.

Siddharth Sihag, CEO, Udaipur Smart City Ltd., informed that the initiative will first be kick-started from ward no. 10. As part of the campaign, an enrolment camp will be organized on Monday, Aug 8, 2016. 100 cards will be made on the occasion. Post that all the health information of the applicants will be synced with their mobile numbers. After the pilot phase with 100, the entire ward will be taken online and finally the services will be rolled out across all wards.

Once the participants have their health information synced with their mobile numbers, whenever they go for their next check-up at Government or private set-ups, the doctors will be able to get a ready access to their past medical history, diseases, tests, medicines taken, medicines being continued etc. This would enable provision of better consultation.

DE against LPG providers

Udaipur: A departmental case has been registered against LPG Cylinder providers in Hathipole and Sector 11 for collecting Rs 100 against issuing application forms under the Prime Minister Ujjawal Scheme. Complaints towards the illegal collection of application fees was received against these centres post which inquiry was initiated.

Jashoda Indian Gas Services, Hathipole, M/s Meera Gas Services and M/s Nutan Gas Services, Sector-11 were found guilty under the complaints. Post that the department has penalised the three vendors by confiscating their security deposits.

The three vendors have also warned that any such action in future will command a termination of license.

Consolidated Ambulance services from IDay

Udaipur: Services of 108 emergency ambulance, 104 expecting mother ambulance and Base ambulances will be merged from IDay onward. Consolidated services will be rendered by the NGO GVK EMRI.

CMHO Dr Sanjeev Taank informed that consolidation of the services will allow for optimal and more efficient utilisation of the available ambulances. He said that the service will now be rendered under the unified banner of "Jeevan Vahini".

Dr Sanjeev informed that there are currently 27 ambulances providing 108 service, 35 ambulances for expecting mothers and 12 base ambulances. Post Aug 15, all the ambulances will be run under a unified banner. Based on the call received by common populace, ambulances will be rendered depending on the requirement i.e. 108 wherever there is emergency, 104 for expecting mothers and base ambulances in non-emergency cases. Cross utilisation of ambulances will also happen whenever any particular serving ambulance is not available.

Madar Village announced Open-Defecation Free

Udaipur: As part of Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan, yet another village Madar made a huge leap by becoming an Open-Defecation Free (ODF) village.

DM Rohit Gupta made the announcement and congratulated the village community for the same. He talked about the significance of hygiene factors and patted the village community for meeting the ODF target. The villagers took out a celebratory rally on the occasion to express their accomplishment, satisfaction and happiness.

MPUAT : All set for student council elections

Udaipur: As per the directions from the State Government, elections for the student council body for MPUAT is all set for student elections. Announcement of the elections has been made by the Directorate of Students Welfare.

With the announcement of election date, the model code of conduct is now in place. Any candidate found violating the model code of candidate will be disqualified from the process. As per the information received from the Directorate of Students Welfare, final electoral list will be released on August 10. Candidates will be able to file their nomination for various positions on Aug 11 from 10 am in the morning till 3pm in the afternoon. Candidates will be able to take their names back on Aug 12 post which the final list of candidates will be released. Elections will be held from 10am in the morning till 1pm in the afternoon on Aug 17 and the results will be announced on the same day evening.

Chief Election Commissioner Y.C. Bhatt has formed a committee of election officers and counting in-charges. The entire electoral process will be carried as per the student constitution, Lyngdoh committee recommendation and state government guidelines.

High Speed Trains from 2019

Udaipur: If electrification of udaipur Ajmer division being completed by December 2018 than High speed trains with speeds upto 110km will soon start plying on the Udaipur-Ajmer circuit. Foundation stone for electrification of the Ajmer-Udaipur route was laid earlier last month near Adarsh Nagar railway station in Ajmer.

Estimated to be electrified at a cost of around Rs 315 Crores, the project is expected to be completed by Dec 2018. Post initial trials, electric trains between Ajmer and Udaipur will start plying from Mar 2019.

Currently, the section between Udaipur to Ajmer runs on Diesel engines. Doubling of tracks in the 294 km section will also help in doing away with the diesel engines and will help in reducing air pollution. Track doubling will also help in easing up the situation when two trains need to cross each other. Currently, on certain sections, one train has to stop till the other passes by.

Udaipur Ahmedabad soon to be six-laned Road

Udaipur: Driving from Udaipur to Gujarat is all set to become more smoother, faster and convenient with the six-laning of NH-8 from Udaipur to Rajasthan/Gujarat border.

IRB Infrastructure developers were announced as the preferred bidder for the project of six laning from Udaipur to Rajasthan/Gujarat border. The contract has been given on a Design, Build, Finance, Operate and Transfer (DBFOT) model. The estimated project cost for the company is estimated at Rs 2100 Crores.

The company will be given a 21 year concession period for this and is expected to complete the construction in 910 days. The project has been given out for the stretch between km 287.400 and km 401.200 of NH-8.

FORTI to Take up Rani Road Pathway

Udaipur: Pathway on Rani Road (Dewali side) has been allotted to industrial organisation FORTI. Survey of the area was carried out by the FORTI team on last Sunday and work is expected to begin soon.

Praveen Suthar informed that initial survey of the area has been completed and an MoU will be signed shortly for initiating work. On the occasion, Praveen Suthar urged every FORTI member to work with full fervour for the benefit of citizens.
