17 Army Jawans Martyred In Uri Terror Strike

Srinagar: Seventeen soldiers and four terrorists were killed on Sunday during an attack at an army camp in Jammu and Kashmir's Uri town, said defence sources

"Jammu and Kashmir has always been worst victim of Indo-Pak hostility and its people have been paying a colossal price for same for past over 6 decades," Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Mehbooba Mufti said.

"Heartfelt condolences to bereaved families and also pray for early recovery of those injured in the attack," the chief minister. "Strongly condemn Uri attack. Attack seems to be aimed at triggering fresh violence and creating a war-like situation in the region," she stated.

After high level meeting with senior officers, Home Minister Rajnath Singh, tweeted "I am

deeply disappointed with Pakistan's continued and direct support to terrorism and terrorist groups." "There are definite and conclusive indications that the perpetrators of Uri attack were highly trained, heavily armed and specially equipped. Pakistan is a terrorist state and it should be identified and isolated as such," the Home Minister mentioned.

PM in his Tweet says "My heartfelt condolences to the families of the martyred soldiers. Those behind this terror incident would be brought to justice.

Deeply distressed at the terror incident in Uri and the loss of 17 brave soldiers martyred. I pray for the speedy recovery of the injured," he added.

"Cong. concerned over deteriorating law and order

"Leader of the Congress in the Lok Sabha M. Mallikarjun Kharge has expressed deep concern over the deteriorating law and order situation in the

Kashmir valley and the increasing civilian toll and also of the security forces in the conflict between the security agencies and the general public.

"Despite the solid support and cooperation extended by the Opposition parties to the BJP-led NDA government at the Centre to find an amicable solution to the conflict in Kashmir, the Union government has

failed to restore normalcy in the troubled valley," Mr. Kharge said.

"Talking to a national daily on Sunday, Mr. Kharge said that there was an effective mechanism to avert cross-border terrorism by Pakistan and counter the Pakistan-instigated violence in the valley.

"The Union government should immediately open the doors of dialogue with all groups in the valley and the people of the Kashmir should be taken into confidence. "In the interest of the nation, Kashmir in particular, there is an urgent need for ushering in normalcy in the valley," he added.

"On the Arunchal Pradesh episode where a majority of Congress MLAs deserted the party and joined the People's Party of Arunachal, which is part of the North Eastern Democratic Alliance, the north

eastern chapter of the NDA, Mr. Kharge alleged that this was the larger part of the BJP agenda to topple the Congress-led governments in the North Eastern States by blackmail and coercion.

"Kharge expressed shock and condemned the brazen attack on an army camp in Uri near the Line of Control (LoC) in the early hours of Sunday killing 17 soldiers and injuring several others.

"Mr. Kharge paid his tributes to the valiant soldiers who laid down their life in the defence of the country and said that such attacks by the militants and infiltrators from Pakistan should not be tolerated any more.

The Union government should act appropriately and give a fitting reply to such brazen attacks on the army and its installations.

First Successful Redo Ascending Aortic Aneurysm Operation in Rajasthan

Udaipur: Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital's Cardiac Surgeon Dr. Sanjay Gandhi performed a successful redo ascending aorta aneurysm operation on 2nd September 2016. Dr. Reenus Demel & Dr. Ravi Patel, cardiac surgeons; Dr. Ankur Gandhi, Dr. Manmohan, Dr. Kalpesh & Dr. Dharamchand; cardiac anaesthetists assisted Dr. Sanjay Gandhi in the procedure. Dr. Sanjay Gandhi (Cardiac Thoracic & Vascular Surgeon) said that Boondi resident, Om Prakash Jain (Age 58 years) underwent aortic valve replacement surgery 6 years ago at Fortis Hospital, Jaipur. On a routine check-up at Kota, in C.T. Scan & ECHO investigations it was found that the aorta is dilated with aneurysm and need immediate surgical treatment. After a visit to renowned hospitals of Delhi, Jaipur & Ahmedabad it was being told to them that the operation is very risky and may cause death of the patient. Referring the website of Geetanjali Hospital, they consulted here and were being treated on



admission. Angiography procedure was performed by Cardiologist Dr. Ramesh Patel to see the coronary arteries of the patient. After this the patient was operated and the ascending aorta was replaced and coronary arteries were re-implanted successfully. The surgery lasted 9 hours. Why this procedure was complex? Dr. Sanjay Gandhi said that since the patient was re-operated 2nd time because of heart disease, it was very risky to his life. The aorta could rupture any moment causing internal bleeding and ultimate death of the patient. Generally, the ascending aorta measures 2.5 centimeters but in this case it was approximately 10 centimeter

which could rupture any time. The Ascending aorta is a portion of the aorta commencing at the upper part of the base of the heart which supplies oxygenated blood through arteries in our body. Aneurysm is a balloon shaped dilatation formed in arteries causing enlargement of artery which can rupture and may cause death of the patient. In this patient the ascending aorta was measuring 4 times then the normal diameter which was very dangerous for patient's life, he said. During press meet CEO of PIMCH informed the steps taken for awareness to common beings. He revealed the steps taken after assuming the office of CEO.

Land of Meera Kala Mandir for Fire Station

Udaipur: The decision of setting up a fire station at three shops' land was taken by the disaster management committee. The land is situated at Patel Circle which was earlier taken back by Municipal Corporation from the Meera Kala Mandir. Reportedly, the conditions of allotment of this land were not fulfilled and corporation has taken the land back from MKM. Committee president apprised that as alternative, a small fire truck remain parked here.

Business convention 'Jhalak 2016' to commence from 22nd



Udaipur: A 3-day regional silver jubilee convention of Rajasthan Tent Dealers' Rental Business Committee 'Jhalak 2016' is to be organized by Udaipur District Tent Business Committee from 22nd to 24th September at BN Ground under the leadership of President Sudhir Chawat. Strongly protesting, submitted a memorandum to the collector addressing the PM

Udaipur: A rally, protesting the proposal to reduce the upper age limit of the General category candidates from 32 years to 26 years, reached the collectorate on Friday. The Collectorate was choc-a-bloc as a large group of protestors, mostly youth came in throngs to present a memorandum to the Collector demanding a fair hearing on the recommendations of the Baswan Committee. All roads leading to the Collectors office, viz. Delhi Gate, Court Chauraha, Surajpol road, Ashwini Bazaar faced a tremendous traffic jam due to the rally.

The protestors were challenging the Baswan Committee report, under which it has been proposed to reduce the age limit of the General Category candidates from 32 to 26. Calling it mass discrimination, the protestors, under the Aegis of the Samanya Varg Ekta Manch said that this proposal further reduces the chances for the General Category aspirants at the UPSC Examinations.



Already faced with heavy reservation policies of the government(s) that have taken place in the past years for various government and private examinations as well as seat reservations in various Public Services, the Baswan Committee proposal speaks a discriminatory language reducing the competition poised by the General Category candidates much further, thereby all but shutting off most options. The memorandum submitted to the Collector, further said that the proposal is completely against the substance of the Indian Constitution and equal opportunity practice. Adding, that the proposal

will be injustice to the lakhs of aspirants in the villages and those competing under local dialects as there is major discrepancy in school admission age thereby reducing preparation and competition chances further.

The memorandum also said that this retrogressive decision will have an adverse impact on the leadership quality of Civil Servants and the gap between efficient and inefficient workers will increase further. This retrogressive experiment has the full potential of destroying the capabilities and skills at village level and is an utter human rights violation leading to brain drain.

Chandrodaya temple taller than Burj Khalifa

New Delhi: The under-construction Chandrodya Mandir in Vrindavan, designed to be the world's tallest temple, will have its foundation five metres deeper than the Burj Khalifa in Dubai. "The foundation of the Burj Khalifa is 50 metres. The temple's foundation is 55-metre deep. The foundation will have 511 columns, which will be completed by March next year," said Narasimha Das, senior vice-president and project director of the temple. "The work on 140 columns has been completed till now and rest of the columns are under construction," he said. The temple is unique for a number of reasons, including its height, forests and theme park. "The attractions planned in the theme park would be like dark rides, animatronics, light, sound and special effects as well as the Vraja Mandal parikrama shows and laser shows, that celebrate the various lilas of Krishna in different forests of Vrindavan," Das said. "Besides, the park will feature a Yamuna Creek, musical fountains, day and night floats, gardens, lawns, water features and others," he said. It will have four temples and 12 forests. These forests, designed next to the temple, will be recreation of 12 forests of Vraja. "The 12 forests will be Madhavana, Talavana, Kumudavana, Bahulavana, Kamyavana, Khadiravana, Vrindavana, Bhadravana, Bilvavana (Belvan), Lohavana (Lauhavana), Bhandiravana and Mahavana," Das said. "The structure will be in a plus sign with four temples on each end. These temples will be of Krishna-Radha, Krishna- Balram, Chaitanya Mahaprabhu and Swami Prabhupada," he said.
