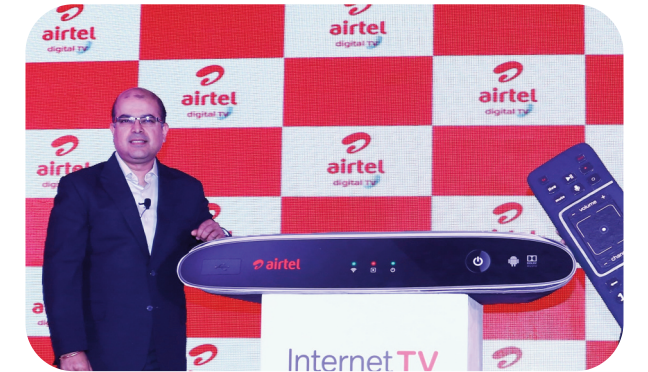
Dharmendra, Mahima Chaudhry Came At Awards Ceremony
