Rajiv Gandhi's 26th death anniversary: Pranab Mukherjee, Sonia Gandhi among others pay tribute

New Delhi: President Pranab Mukherjee, Vice President Hamid Ansari along with Congress president Sonia Gandhi, her son and party vice-president Rahul Gandhi, and daughter Priyanka Gandhi Vadra on Sunday paid tributes to former prime minister Rajiv Gandhi on his 26th death anniversary. They laid flowers and wreaths at the Rajiv Gandhi memorial, 'Vir Bhumi' in New Delhi. The party also launched a campaign to have more reservation for women in politics. Former prime minister Manmohan Singh was also present at the gathering along with other dignitaries. West Bengal chief minister Mamata Banerjee too paid trib-

utes to the former prime minister and said she would always remember the shock and pain of his "untimely demise". NCP leader and former Congressman Sharad Pawar tweeted an old photo of him with the late prime minister. To observe the late prime minister's death anniversary, Congress will launch a nationwide signature campaign demanding 33 percent reservation of seats for women in all Assembly and Parliamentary elections. Rajiv Gandhi was assassinated on this day in 1991 in a suicide bomb attack by Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam (LTTE) during an election rally at Sriperumbudur in Tamil Nadu. He had succeeded his mother Indira Gandhi as prime min-



ister, after her assassination in October 1984.

He served as prime minister from 31 October, 1984, to 2 December, 1989. He had succeeded to the position after his mother Indira Gandhi was assassinated by her Sikh body-

guards on 31 October, 1984 in Udaipur. On the martyr's day of Bharat Ratna, Rajiv Gandhi, the Udaipur City District Congress Committee presented a floral tribute at the Rajiv Gandhi Memorial Garden on the Rani Road. Later, plan-

Much awaited UIT Pulia opened

Udaipur: Home Minister Gulabchand Kataria, Urban Development and local self, State Minister Shri chand Kripalani and Rural Development Minister of State Panchayati Raj Dhan Singh Rawat. Jointly unveiled the bridge connect UIT with Chetak Circle.

Addressing the function organized on this occasion, the Home Minister, Mr. Kataria congratulated UIT officials for completion of Pulia work one month before the due date. Shri Kataria said that UIT and the Municipal Corporation are working in harmony for the development of the city. He said that in last 15 days, for the development of Udaipur, the sanction of works of 35 crores for urban development ministry the city The city has got many important committees.

Shri Kataria said that in order to minimize the pressure of traffic in Udaipur, approval of 7 crore has been issued for the much-anticipated Thakur Chaurah railway under pass. Also efforts are being made for acceptance of other underpasses and over bridges. Shri Kataria said that the Maharana Pratap Khel Gaion of Udaipur is in constant



progress for organizing world class sports. The Multipurpose Indoor Stadium, which will cost Rs 27 crore here, will be unique across the nation.

The Home Minister said that obstacles arising due to the technical reasons of the work of Bird Park, constructed at a cost of 11 crores in Gulab bagh, have now been removed. This tender has been finalized and the work will start soon. He said that overall efforts are being made to make a big pond in Udaipur favorable to various competitions under the Water Sports Academy. At the same time, various amenities and beautification works are also proposed to attract tourists. Shri Kataria said that the approval of 1.60 crore has been approved for the development of Sajjangarh area, Chief Point of Udaipur. Along

with this, it will be easier to reach there directly from main Udaipur city. The Flower Valley of 1.60 crores will be developed at old way of disembodied Chirwa Ghat with tourism in terms of traffic near the city. The Home Minister said that for the establishment of a science park in Udaipur, the central and state government has sanctioned Rs. 2.5 crore and the sanction of this amount will create a great science park. Shri Kataria said that due to the completion of Dewas first and second, drinking water problem of Udaipur and adjoining areas could be overcome. The government is also pursuing the plan to reach the water supply through the Mahis Tunnel and to reach Jaisamand's water to Rajsamand. Shri Kataria said that after get-

ting approval of 1500 crores for Udaipur Mavali Marwar rail line, new dimensions of industrial development of the area will be established. On the other hand, the installation of elevated road in the city, the Kishangarh-Ahmedabad 6-lane highway of 2500 crore, the Nimaja mata Ropeway, Ayad river beautification, Hemraj National Laboratory in the city, the development of other parking spots including the SIERT land at the Devali end, will give new direction to the development of the city.

At the function, Urban Development Minister Shrichand Kripalani said that with the leading thinking of Chief Minister Smt. Vasundhara Raje, all the Municipal body areas of Rajasthan are heading towards becoming beautiful and smarter. LED lights and other development works are continuing at a cost of 600 crores. All the municipalities are being added to the videoconferencing, while every needy person can get food at cheaper rate, Annapurna van is available in every city. Dhan Singh Rawat, UIT chair man Ravindra Shrimali Mayor CSKothari and other officials were present in inaugural function.

All Set For Flaging Off High-Speed Tejas

New Delhi: The Tejas Express, a semi high speed train, to be flagged off on Monday from Dadar by Union Minister for Railways Suresh Prabhu through video conferencing.

The train between Chatrapati Shivaji terminus in Mumbai and Karmali in Goa will run five days a week and the inaugural train will reach Karmali, Goa at 35 minutes past midnight on Tuesday. The train boasts of modern facilities with enhanced passenger comfort and showcases the future of Train travel in India.

As for the facilities of the train, it is equipped with hi tec facilities like LED TV, WiFi, CCTV as well as fire and smoke detection facilities and tea, coffee vending machines as well. Automatic doors till now seen only in metro trains are there in this train too. t also has bio-vacuum toilets and hand dryers as

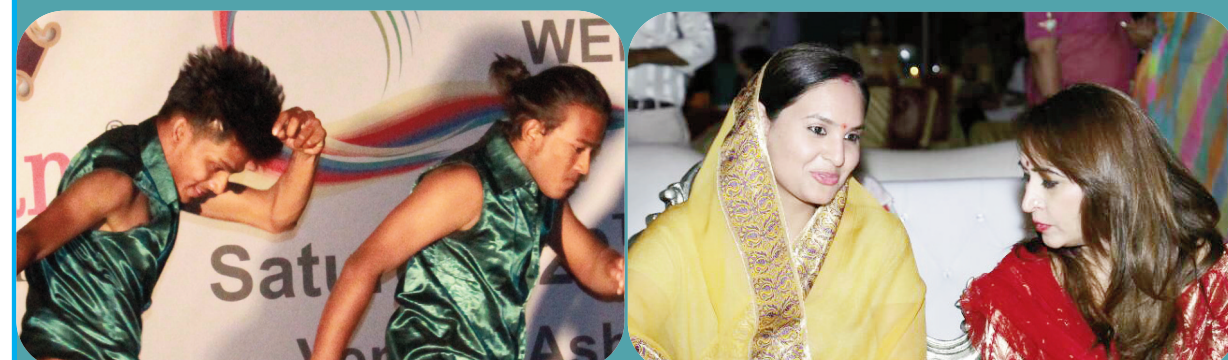
well as a GPS based information service.

Its bogies are designed in such a way that despite the high speed, passengers sitting in it will feel none of the bumps and jolts and will easily be able to go from one bogey to another whatever be the speed.

The train will have an executive AC Chair Car with the capacity to seat 56 people and each bogey will have 12 AC Chair car with 78 seats capacity. Tejas Express's executive class fare has been earmarked at Rs 2,680 and without food it will be 2,525 rupees. The rent of AC Chair Car has been fixed at Rs 1,280 with food and Rs 1,155 without food. As the train is equipped with the best facilities, fares have been kept slightly highly more than normal mail or express train fares.

Nail-Biting Finale Over

Hyderabad: A magnificent death bowling saw Mumbai Indians snatch an incredible one-run victory from the jaws of defeat against Rising Pune Supergiant in a thrilling final of the Indian Premier League here tonight. This was Mumbai Indians' third IPL trophy in 10 editions; and with this win, their skipper Rohit Sharma became the only captain to win a hat-trick of titles. For Mahendra Singh Dhoni, it was yet another final that ended in a defeat -- fifth in seven summit clashes.

In one of the closest finals in 10 editions, the trio of Jasprit Bumrah (2/26), Mitchell Johnson (3/26) and Lasith Malinga (0/21) was brilliant at the death, defending a small total of 129/8 as Supergiant were restricted to 128/6 at the end. In the final over in which Pune needed 11 runs, Johnson his nerve and kept Pune one run short of the target. Manoj Tiwary smacked the first ball to the mid-wicket boundary, bringing the equation down to 7 from 5 balls. However, the next two deliveries turned out to be a disaster with both Tiwary and skipper Steve Smith (51 off 50 balls) caught in the deep. With four required off the final ball for a win and 3 for a Super Over, Dan Christian went for an impossible third run, only to find himself getting run out. Bumrah and Malinga gave away just 10 runs in the 17th and 18th overs, putting Pune under a lot of pressure.

Tricky target

The 130-run target was rather small but Mumbai still managed to eke out a thrilling win. Pune needed 47 runs off the last five overs with Smith and MS Dhoni on the crease. With eight wickets in hand and the two stalwarts in the middle, the target looked very much gettable. However, Bumrah induced an edge from Dhoni's bat to bring some sheer to the Mumbai camp. Thereafter, the Mumbai bowlers choked the flow of runs and Pune finished just a run short.

Mumbai struggle

Earlier, Rising Pune Supergiant stifled Mumbai Indians to 129/8. The eventual champions were completely off-colour with the willow as they played an astounding 54 dot balls (9 maiden overs) in 20 overs. Save for Krunal (47 off 38 balls), none of the MI batsmen showed the judiciousness expected in a game as big as this. It was because of Krunal's late hitting (three fours and two sixes) that MI managed to reach 129 after being reduced to 79/7.
