Director of Kudo in North India and President of Rajasthan Kudo and 6 degree Blackbelt Renshi Rajkumar Menaria said that 118 players from Rajasthan participated in different categories of men and women category, & shown supremacy by winning the medals.

senior journalist Sudhir Chaudhary, Bollywood star Katrina Kaif, & Akshay Kumar graced the award giving ceremony. Rajasthan team grabbed 21 gold, 20 silver and 18 bronze medals.

Rajasthan team of Kudo, performed brilliantly. A special award was announced for the Kudo India team.. Akshay Kumar announced for the sending of the top ten players of the country to the Philippines for 1 month free training at international level. The selection of the boys will be done by the National Selection Council.

Menaria said that in these 59 medals, 5 districts of Rajasthan had a special contribution. In which Udaipur won the first position in the team by winning 7 gold, 5 silver and 7 bronze medals, totaling 19 medals. Bikaner Rajasthan won 4 gold, 5 silver and 1 Bronze, Barmer has 1 silver and 1 Bronze, Alwar-Bhiwadi 5 gold, 5 silver and 3 Bronze, Jodhpur 5 gold, 12 medals, including 4 silver and 3 Bronze Third in the team. On 10 out of 19 medals from Udaipur, daughters and 9 sons were captured. Baby feeding room launched at Udaipur Railway station

Udaipur: Members of Inner Wheel club Udaipur gifted "Mamta" baby feeding room at Udaipur railway station. The inauguration ceremony was performed by club president Sheela Talesra, District chairman Sunita Jain, Secretary Devika Singhvi, Station Manager SC Verma and Vice President Asha Kunawat along with others jointly.

Talesra informed that Inner Wheel Club has launched a new project under the name of Mamta baby feeding rooms and the set up at city railway station is the start of the project. This room will also mothers to feed their babies without any trouble in a comfortable environment.

President Asha Kunawat said that room provided provision for two mothers to simultaneously feed their babies. Each room has two tables along with light and fan. The room will remain open for 24 hours with one key being permanently placed at the door. Mothers may feed their baby and either put the key back outside the door or hand it over to station officials.

The feeding rooms will also serve the purpose of educating mothers about importance of feeding their babies. Talesra said that more feeding rooms may be established at a later date depending on requirement.

Miraj Morning : First RERA certified building project

Udaipur: Miraj Morning was first to get the Building Completion Certificate (BCC) making it the first such project getting this certificate after the implementation of RERA (Real Estate Regulatory Authority).

Under RERA, it will be a win win project for both the developer and home owner, as once the building gets a BCC certificate under RERA, no GST will be applicable, taking down the final ownership cost by around 12% under the current market scenario, said Prabhakar Shukla. Other Nathdwara projects of Miraj, viz. Miraj Meridian have also secured the building completion certificate under RERA.

Country's first leopard project to start in Jaisamand sanctuary

Udaipur: Rajasthan forest department will soon start a pilot project for protecting leopard and its habitats in three wildlife sanctuaries. This will be the first of its kind initiative in India.

The pilot project will be launched in 3 sanctuaries at an estimated cost of Rs 21 Crores. Three sanctuaries have been identified as Jaisamand sanctuary, Kumbalgarh sanctuary-Raoli Todgarh sanctuary and Jhalana Aamagarh Conservation Reserve in Jaipur.

Readers may note that CM Raje had allocated Rs 7 Crore in 2017-18 budget for Project Leopard. The balance Rs 14 Crore will be taken from Compensatory Afforestation Management and Planning Authority (CAMPAA) fund.

The project will try to conserve the endangered animal by controlling poaching, mitigating conflict with humans and increasing its prey base.

There were 434 leopards in Rajasthan as per wildlife census done in 2015.

The Project Leopard is being launched along the same lines

as Project Tiger that was launched in 1973.

Ring road at Udaipur proposed under Bharatmala project

Udaipur: Udaipur is one of the 28 cities that have been identified for construction of a ring road under the Bharatmala project to unclog traffic in various cities across India. 45 bypasses have also been planned under the project.

Ring roads have been planned in Udaipur, Bengaluru, Pune, Sambalpur, Madurai, Indore, Dhule, Raipur, Shivpur, Delhi, Bhubaneswar, Gurugram, Surat, Patna, Lucknow, Varanasi, Vijayawada, Chitradurga, Amravati (AP), Sagar, Solapur, Jaipur, Belgaum, Nagpur, Agra, Kota, Dhanbad and Ranchi.

Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari on Wednesday presented a blueprint to the media a day after the Union Cabinet approved Phase I of Bharatmala Pariyojana.

According to MoRTH Secretary Yudhvir Singh Malik, the stretches have been identified after scientific study of traffic pattern of all the identified ring roads and bypasses all over the country.

Gadkari said that the Ministry has finalised the proposals to construct 28 new ring roads. A total of around 600 projects have been identified across the components for Bharatmala which is a new umbrella programme for the highways sector that focuses on optimising the efficiency of road traffic movement across the country by bridging critical infrastructure gaps.

With this projects, India will have "world-class roads on par with the US and Germany" and special emphasis has been accorded to providing quality roads on borders adjoining China and Pakistan, besides far-flung tribal areas. "The entire programme will be transparent, corruption-free with full emphasis on quality. Each and every work will be through electronic tenders and the quality of highways would be such that they would see no potholes for the next 100 years," Gadkari said.

Gadkari said, "The Bharatmala project is the biggest ever infrastructural project taken in the country." While further talking about it, he added, "Bharatmala will lead to significant improvements in road safety and save lives."

Special Passport Camp in Udaipur on 4 - Nov

Udaipur: Considering the long waiting time in getting appointments at Passport Seva Laghu Kendra, Udaipur, the regional passport office Jaipur will organise a special passport camp on 4-Nov in Udaipur. Appointments will be made available on 26-Oct at 1pm. Regional Passport Officer, S.R.Meena said that 350 appointments will be given out during the passport camp. Only those passport applications that deal with fresh passport or passport renewal will be entertained in the camp.

Tatkal Passport applications and PCC applications will not be accepted during the camp. Further, those applicants whose applications are currently under process at passport offices will also not be entertained. Applicants will have to make the payment online and will have to select PSLK Udaipur as the centre and 04-Nov as the appointment date. Applicants can log on to www.passportindia.gov.in for applying.
