## Southern Rajasthan's first MRI safe combo device implantation at GBH



**Udaipur:** MRI safe combo device (CRT-D) implantation was done at the cardiac and vascular center of GBH American Hospital. This is the first time in Southern Rajasthan.

This information was given by Dr. Amit Khandelwal, Cardiac Director and Senior Interventional Cardiologist, GBH American Hospital in a press conference on Saturday. He told about CRT-D.

"An implanted cardiac resynchronization device is a medical device used in cardiac resynchronization therapy (CRT). It resynchronizes the contractions of the heart's ventricles by sending tiny electrical impulses to the heart muscle, which can help the heart pump blood throughout the body more efficiently," so far, MRI of such patients could not be possible, because magnetic attraction in MRI creates interference in pacemaker's work. With MRI safe combo device, such patients will not have any problem in getting MRI.

Dr. Khandelwal said that many times the news of sudden death of the healthy person is heard, it can be due to the complete cardiac arrest. Such patients are required to reach the nearest Cardiac Center at the earliest, but due to the traffic pressure in the city and immediate ambulance facility is not available, they can't but it the patient is immediately identified at the full facility center. He can't get relief GBH is in middle of City and this facility will provide a great relief to the patients.

According to Dr. Khandelwal, such patients need urgent CPR to prevent the cardiac arrest, and many patients also need CRT-D. In this life saving process, MRI safe combo device will prove to be a boon for patients. Dr. Khandelwal told that there is a great deal of time for this.

Facility of this device was limited to major cities like Ahmedabad, Jaipur, Mumbai, Delhi, but now it has been started at GBH American Hospital. This is the first center of Southern Rajasthan where it has been started. Also, GBH's Cathlab has been upgraded by providing useful resources for it.

Dr. Anand Jha, group director of GBH said, GBH American Hospital will soon start training on CPR. Anyone anywhere will be able to save lives by giving CPR to such a situation. In the press conference, Group Director Medical Services Dr. Dinesh Sharma and Director Dr. Surabhi Jain were present.

### Free Medical Camp from 7th November

Group Director Dr. Anand Jha said that a massive heart disease free medical camp will be held in GBH American Hospital from November 7 to 9. In this, the biggest benefit of this will be given to heart patients. Consultation, ECG and lipid profile check will be made free. Apart from this, TMT and Eco screening will be done in just Rs 100 and angiography will be offered only in 2900 rupees and angioplasty will be done in Rs 30 thousand rupees.
