Udaipur: A meeting held under the chairmanship of Shanti Lal Chaplot, Convener of Mewar Wagde High Court Bench Sangharsh Committee at court campus recently to achieve the goal of HC Bench in Udaipur. The strategy of the movement has been decided in the meeting. The committee will start an indefinite gradual agitation outside the district court premises on April 16, before it this general house meeting will be convened on all the district headquarters of the division on April 13. This decision was taken at the meeting of Divisional Level Committee and Bar Association of the Divisional

Level Committee of the Mewar Wagad High Court Bench Sangharsh Committee, Udaipur, on Saturday. The decision was informed by General Secretary of the Committee, Shanti Lal Pamacha, that the meeting was unanimously demanded before the assembly elections. The order of High courts bench should be released by Government else it will have a major set back to ruling party. It has been decided to convene 11 advocates on fast during the commencement of the continuous fasting at the divisional level from 16th April. Apart from this, the meeting will be held on April 16 with state CM and Chief Justice,

Rajasthan. It was decided to send the registered information. Even after getting the information, if the government does not pay attention to this demand, then the former Speaker of the Assembly, & Mewar Wagad High Court Bench, Sangharsh Samiti's Convener Shantilal Chaplot has repeated his declaration of sitting on fast unto death till the acceptance of the High Court bench. In addition to the continuous hunger strike in the meeting, it was decided for sending door-to-door letters and connecting the masses with this movement. Ramesh Nandawana said that in the district level General House to be

held on April 13 and 16, a representative delegation of officials will be sent on behalf of the committee, who will hold their views on the strategy of the movement. In the meeting, Bar Association's current President Ram Kripa Sharma, General Secretary Chetan Puri G o s w a m i Secretary Om Prakash Prajapat Finance Secretary Harish Sharma Library Secretary Hemant Paliwal Shambhu Singh Rathore, shared their views.

Udaipur Breaks World Record by Donating more than Three Lakh pieces of Clothing



Udaipur: 76,000 donors from across the globe donated more than 3 lakh pieces of clothing to break the world record in clothing donation today.

The campaign was organised by Shri Lakshyaraj Singh Mewar. The previous world record was held by Dubai

where the local citizens had donated 295,122 articles of clothing in 2016.

Speaking about the achievement, Shri Lakshyaraj Singh Mewar said, "Roti, Kapda and Makaan are considered to be the three most essential needs. Donation drives, including government schemes,

focus on food and housing, but we forget how important clothing is.

Breaking the record is just the beginning for us—the next step is to distribute these clothes to lakhs of people from underserved communities across India".

The campaign had been flagged off by Shri Lakshyaraj Singh Mewar on 15th January 2018 and ran for 3 months with the help of 1700 volunteers from around the globe.

It culminated with the counting of the donated clothing articles on Sunday morning at the Shikarbad hotel, Udaipur. Donations came in from more than 12 countries including

Australia, USA, Oman, Sri Lanka and the UAE. More than 80 drop points within and outside India were set up for the campaign.

"We have had an overwhelming response from across the world to our call to action. Breaking the world record will help cement Udaipur's name on the world map as not just City of lakes, but also as a City with the Big Hearts," added Shri Lakshyaraj Singh Mewar.
