## Hindustan Zinc Silver Refinery Recognized by London Bullion Market Association (LBMA)



Hindustan Zinc is the only Indian private sector company to feature in London Bullion Market Association's (LBMA) global 82 "London Good Delivery" list. As per World Silver Survey 2018 by The Silver Institute, Hindustan Zinc, that produces over 95% of primary silver in India, is the 10th largest Silver producer in the world. The Silver refinery of Hindustan Zinc, located at Pantnagar in the State of Uttarakhand, has been added to London Bullion Market Association's (LBMA) "London Good Delivery" list for Silver with effect from 16 April 2018. The LBMA is the international trade association that represents the wholesale over-the-counter market for gold and silver bullion. It lists those refineries whose gold and silver bars have been found, when originally tested, and met the required standard for acceptability in the London Bullion market. The List now includes 69 gold and 82 silver refiners. LBMA has exhaustive testing procedures under which silver bars are examined and assayed by independent referees, and assaying capabilities are tested. It also includes assessment of company's ownership, history, production capability and financial standing. The LBMA recognition to Hindustan Zinc for Silver has become effective from 16th April 2018. This

gives Hindustan Zinc certification of international standards quality of silver bars that match global trade acceptability.

Hindustan Zinc Silver refinery is India's third refinery and the only private sector refinery to be listed on LBMA. The other listed refineries from India are MMTC Pamp, Mewat and Hindustan Platinum Pvt. Ltd, Navi Mumbai, both of government.

The CEO of Hindustan Zinc, Sunil Duggal said "We are very pleased to receive recognition by London Bullion Market Association (LBMA) for our silver refinery located at Pantnagar in the State of Uttarakhand. Since we represent India in global silver market, with production of 95% primary silver in India, I would like to attribute Hindustan Zinc silver as #Silver of India." As per the latest World Silver Survey report 2018, Hindustan Zinc ranked 10th among the top Silver producing companies globally in the year 2017. The report also showcases 2017 as the third consecutive year of growth posted in India due to higher silver grades and ore volumes processed by Hindustan Zinc. The company jumped 8 positions from its 2016 ranking of 18.

In the financial year 2017-18, Hindustan Zinc has produced a record 556 tonnes of silver. The Company sells Silver in the form of 30 kilograms' bars. ## Hunger strike demanding HC bench in Udaipur in full swing

Udaipur: Serial hunger strike demanding HC bench in Udaipur is in full swing on the second-day female advocates sit on hunger strike. The female advocates participated in the strike demanding the establishment of High Court bench in Udaipur. Ex-MLA from Udaipur Rural, Sajjan Katara and members of Aam Aadmi party also supported the protesting advocates and demanded that the state government establish High Court bench in Udaipur. While the protesting advocates had boycotted judicial work on the first day of the strike, the regular work proceedings were not hindered regularly up to some extent. The strike is being carried out under the banner of High Court Sangharsh Samiti. There will be an interim meeting of members of High Court Sangharsh Samiti to decide as to till when will they continue this serial strike and what action to be taken next. State Government is yet to write to Central Government with any recommendation for the establishment of High Court bench in Udaipur. As a result, the protest by High Court Sangharsh Samiti is set to continue and may even gain further momentum going forward. Advocate Arun Vyas said "56.02 % of the total tribes of the state residing in this belt of Southern Rajasthan, popularly known as Mewar-Vagad

Region has been fighting for a High Court bench in Udaipur for past 3 decades. HC bench has remained a permanent agenda for candidates from all parties seeking votes from the electorate. However, after winning, no one cares to fulfill their promise." Existing Udaipur Division of 6 Districts Udaipur, Rajsamand, Chittorgarh, Dungarpur, Banswara, and Pratappgarh is commonly called the Mewar-Vagad Region. Bhilwara which was separated from Udaipur Division to be included in Ajmer Division still is considered as a part and parcel of the Mewar-Vagad region. Sirohi district falling under Jodhpur division, consisting of Abu Road and Pindwara is neighboring tribal belt of the erstwhile Mewar princely state. Mina, Bhil, Garasia, Damor, Naikda are the main Scheduled Tribe and Meghwal, Salvi, Chamar, Rawal Balai, Khatik, Bairwa, Koli, Sargara are the main Scheduled Caste population of Mewar-Vagad Region. The majority of the SC & ST population depend on agriculture and labor work. The rain-fed fragmented and small holdings in the hills add misery to the plight of the thousands of Adivasi families. In such a condition, to and fro travelling from the litigants' place to abode to Jodhpur for securing Bail or other legal and civil relief, the people of Mewar and Vagad Region of this Southern Rajasthan area is a nightmare for vindicating of their consti-

tutional rights for seeking justice irrespective of the fact that they may have a strong prima facie and good arguable case. A naïve tribal who hasn't seen even a train finds himself hopeless and helpless when he lands at Jodhpur and finds no one to understand his Vagari and Bhomal dialect. Jodhpur, the principal seat of the High Court is at a distance of more than 550 Kms from Danpur, Anandpur, Pipalkunt, Kushalgarh, Pratappgarh and Aronod Tehsil for people in Pratappgarh Banswara, Chittorgarh and Pratappgarh districts. A person has to change buses at three places first to connecting nearest town, then to the nearest place of the district of bus stand and then for Jodhpur. The one-way travel sometimes takes more than 24 hours journey. That's why in the last 10 years there has been only 800 bail appeals and about 18,000 under trials released from jails. Train journey also takes more than 14 hours distant Tehsil headquarters of this region. For a resident of Pratappgarh, one has to reach Mandasaur or Jawad, Neemuch in Madhya Pradesh and then board a train for Ratlam or Chittorgarh and again change train at Mavli, Nathdwara, Marwar Junction to reach Jodhpur. Sirohi part of which is within the Tribal Advisory Sub Plan of Udaipur is with proximity to Udaipur with a distance of 135 Kms than the 160 Km distance to Jodhpur.
