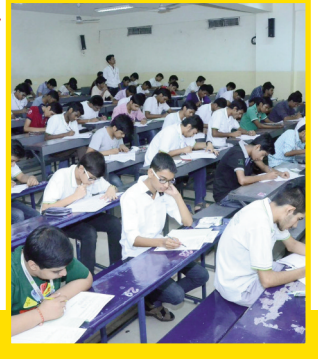

MOTHER'S LOVE FOR EVERY CHILD!

Udaipur: There's no better medicine or immunity booster for an infant other than the breast milk of their mother. However, not all kids are that lucky to have this panacea available. Some kids lose their mothers early while some mothers are not capable enough to breast-feed their kids. In such a case, the infant must be put on external artificial milk, which only saves life. Artificial milk does not provide adequate energy and does

not improve the shield of immunity. This further results into weakness and multiple medical issues. Like other many elements of human needs, the breast milk of women can also be donated. We have heard many stories where women other than the mother have fed kids and gave them the life with strength. But is there a way this milk can be stored for as and when use? Yes, of course. The Divya Mother Milk Bank has been established in



PannadhyChikitsalaya of Udaipur's MaharanaBhupal general hospital where kids can be given stored and preserved real mother milk. The story of mother milk bank began on April 15, 2013 by the founder of Ma BhagwatiSansthanYog Guru DevendraAgarwal. According to the sansthan, in the past five years, more than

111 thousand mothers have donated 2,523,445 liters of milk 25,601 times. More than 6,191 infants have received life with this gesture of these noble ladies. Similarly, 552,821 liters of milk was made available to 209,709 mothers who were unable to feed their infants. Sansthan also helped these mothers to become able to feed

their kids through breast feeding promoting services. This mother bank was handed over to RNT medical college last year on April 6 and since then the noble initiative has become a government run venture. With the support from the administration, the tradition of spreading love has become a wide-spread campaign.

Udaipur's vigilant dweller and a renowned Bhamashah, Mrs. Usha Varsi has become a prominent name in this campaign. Mrs. Usha Varsi learnt about the milk bank in 2011 in Gujarat and since then she resolved to donate milk after turning a mother. Mrs. Varsi has donated 140 times about 17770 milliliters of milk. She



wants to take this tradition forward and inspire other donors as well. Mrs. Varsi was appreciated by the district collector Bishnu Charan Mallick.

Vaibhav Khater a student of Ascent, created history

Udaipur: Vaibhav Khater, a class 10th student of the pre-nurse division of Ascent Career Point, has been selected among Top 4 students of India for the 12th International Earth Science Olympiad (IESO). This information was shared in the press conference organized on Friday, by Manoj Bisarati, Chief Director of Assent Career Point & Brigendra Singh Shaktawat, chief of Ascent Pre-Nurture Division. Vaibhav will represent India on 8th August at the international level in Thailand. Manoj Bisarati, Chief Director of Assent Career Point, on this achievement of Vaibhav, wished his wishes for his bright future. Brigendra Singh Shaktawat said that Vaibhav will take part in the 10-day pre-departure training camp with the top 4 students of the country for the full preparation of the final level. This camp will be held in Mumbai in July by the Geological Society of India in Mumbai. He said that this examination is organized every year by the Geological Society of India. The student must be 18 years of age to participate in this examination. This competition exam is held at four different levels. First Level Written Examination National Level Entry and Second Level Training Camp is held in which 2. Students are selected from the entire country. This training camp is 25 days which is



organized at the University and Research Institute in May-June. The 10-day pre-departure training camp is organized by selecting four best students at the third level. The selected students in the final stage go abroad and represent the country in front of almost 55 countries around the world. The selected student is awarded internationally by Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal.

Pacific Premier League Cricket Tournament – 2018 from 20th August



Udaipur: Pacific Premier League (PPL) cricket tournament under 19 will commence from August 20, 2018, under the auspices of the Pacific University. In this type of tournament for the first time in Rajasthan on the lines of the IPL competition, in which 8 teams will participate. This competition will be played on round robin lines. Colorful dress white ball and black side screen will be used. A trial for the selection of players in the teams will be held at ShikarBadi ground from 07 June

The players who participate in the trial

will have to register first. The registration form can be filled online or in the ShikarBadi by the Wonder Cement Cricket Academy. The player will be selected only after registration. The selected players will be able to participate in the auction of teams. The player's auction will be done by point (digit). In which teams will be given prescribed points. The teams will be formed from the same 15 players. 15 players will be in each team and 5 will be reserved players. Two matches will be played each day. Man of Match and Turning Point player of the Match in each

match will be rewarded. Batsmen, bowlers and fielders, man of the series, Emerging Player and Fair Playing team will also be rewarded with the playing kit and trophy of cricket. During the tournament, the highest scorer batsman and highest wicket-taker will be awarded Purple and Orange Cap respectively.

The winning trophies will be awarded to the winners and runners-up teams and each player will be given a symbol. Each team has a coach & manager who played at national level. Any person can buy 1 of these 8 teams.
