Raje's Gaurav Yatra: 40 days, 165 assembly seats, 6,054 kms

Jaipur: Chief minister Vasundhara Raje's Gaurav Yatra, which begins from August 4, will pass through 165 assembly constituencies with public meetings at 135 locations and cover a total distance of 6,054 km. The 40-day yatra will begin from Charbhujia temple in Rajasamand district and will end at Pushkar on September 30, said state home minister Gulab Chand Kataria, who is the convenor of the yatra. Kataria said the Raje will first visit the Charbhujia temple and from there will go to the JK Stadium in Kankroli where a public meeting is scheduled. BJP national president Amit Shah will flag off the yatra while Prime Minister Narendra Modi is expected to be present at the conclusion. The yatra's duration will be seven days each in Jodhpur, Ajmer and Udaipur divisions, six days in Bikaner division, four days each in Kota and Bharatpur division and five days in Jaipur division. The cost of the yatra

will be borne by the BJP.

He said MP and MLAs will tour their respective constituencies ahead of the yatra to take stock of the preparations. The 35 assemblies left out of the yatra will be covered at a later stage.

Kataria said the BJP government through its work has brought glory to Rajasthan. "We have worked to bring Rajasthan out of the BIMARU state category and brought it in line with leading states in the country. We will give an account of our work to the people," he said.

State BJP president Madan Lal Saini said that the party is going between the people with achievements of the state and central governments. "We have worked to strengthen the organisation with the appointment of vistarkas who will work in 197 assembly constituencies for the assembly and general elections. Now we will go to seek people's support on the basis of the work done by our government."

Taking a dig at Congress president Rahul Gandhi's temple run during Gujarat and Karnataka assembly elections, Rajasthan home minister Gulab Chand Kataria on Tuesday said the temple visits would endow him with good sense.

Kataria's comment came when he was asked about temple visits by Gandhi during the Gujarat and Karnataka assembly elections and the proposed visits in Rajasthan.

"They (Congress) have been forced to learn from us. So far they had only been maligning temples. Now, Rahul too is visiting temples, which is a good sign, it will confer sadbhuddhi (good sense) on him," Kataria replied.

Asked about AICC national general secretary (organisation) Ashok Gehlot's observation that the yatra is a kuraj (bad governance) yatra as there has been no



development in the state under the BJP, Kataria said, "I invite Gehlot to compare Congress's 50 years of governance with our four years. There is no comparison between the work they have done and the work we have done."

10,000 rural people to get safe drinking water by HZL

Udaipur: The company installs two RO plants, four water ATMs and one mobile van ATM to provide safe drinking water in two panchayats in Debari, near Udaipur. Safe drinking water has always been one of the major concerns especially in rural India. To address to this critical issue, Hindustan Zinc installs two water purifying RO plants in 2 Panchayats of Udaipur

namely Maharaj Ki Khedi and Mandesar



in TusDangiyan covering 4 villages. Each plant will function with a purification rate of 1000L/ hour, benefiting over 10,000 rural people of these villages. These plants were inaugurated by the Chief Guest - MLA of Vallabhnagar, Maharaj Randhir Singh Bhindar on 30th July, 2018. During the event, he said "The rural areas face a lot of issues related to safe drinking water and this initiative of Hindustan Zinc was indeed exemplary."

Mr. Sunil Duggal - CEO, Hindustan Zinc and Mr. Amitabh Gupta - CFO, Hindustan Zinc, also visited the plant. During his visit, Mr. Duggal, discussed about the operations of the plant and availability of drinking water in the village.

In association with Water Life, these installed RO plants with a capacity of 3000 litres, are built with the advanced membrane technology with the help of which the water is processed via 10 stages of purification before being dispensed and are backed up by the solar power to prevent its dependency on electricity.
