### Gulab Chand Kataria from Udaipur and Kiran Maheshwari from Rajsamand in BJP List

Udaipur: Responsibility of Elections for the Rajasthan Legislative Assembly elections have been entrusted once again under the command of incumbent Chief Minister VasundhraRajeScindia. 5 names from Udaipur district have been repeated among the 7 released for the division, whereas those from Rajsamand are a repeat from the previous elections. The

candidate from Vallabhnagar is vet to be announced. from 12 November being the day when the nominations for the assembly elections is starting. BJP Central Election Committee under the Presidentship of Amit Shah released their list of candidates for the Raiasthan elections to be held next month, late evening on 11 November. GulabchandKataria and KiranMaheshwari have been nominated to contest from the Udaipur and Rajsamand seats

respectively. Interestingly, with the current atmosphere of polarisation prevalent in the country, the ruling party has NOT FIELDED anv Muslim candidate. However, there are 25 new names in the list of 131 released

by the BJP, after their meeting held yesterday evening at New



Delhi, which was attended by the PM NarendraModi, FM ArunJaitley, MEA SushmaSwaraj and all other members of the CEC-BJP. 12 of these new nominees are women. 27% of the nominees in this first list issued by the BJP are from the reserved categories, i.e. SC-ST. It is apparent that most of the names in the list are those recommended by VasundhraRajeScindia and the influence of the RSS is also visible

Sources suggest one reason why the Congress continues to hold back the list of state candidates (BJP announced its first list three days ago) was the ongoing debate on whether both Gehlot and Pilot should contest. In Madhya Pradesh, another election bound state, for instance, none of the senior leaders — state chief Kamal Nath, campaign panel chief JyotiradityaScindia or poll coordination committee chief Digvijay Singh — are contesting.

Gehlot, a sitting MLA from Sardarpura in Jodhpur, however has never ruled himself out of the CM race and has been clear from the start that he would fight state polls. Even today he said "everyone should fight elections."

Meanwhile Pilot, a close friend of Congress Chief Rahul Gandhi, has remained tight lipped about whether he would contest state elections considering he has never contested for assembly earlier. He was LokSabha MP.



It's learnt that the decision to field both Gehlot and Pilot took a while with Pilot throwing his hat in the ring in the very end should he miss out on the race for state CM-ship in case the Congress wins Rajasthan.Gehlot when asked about the CM face of the party today said the Congress had conventionally never named a CM candidate before elections in Rajasthan."We like to respect that history," he said keeping his own and other options open.Earlier once he had said in response to a question on Congress' CM face, "Do you ever know in advance kaunbanegacrorepati?"As far as Pilot goes, he would ensure a safe seat for himself lest he ends up like his senior CP Joshi, another Rajasthan Congress stalwart, who had lost thr assembly election by one vote in 2008. Joshi was then Rajasthan Congress Chief and Ashok Gehlot went on to become state CM.Sachin Pilot would not want that history to repeat itself.

Kataria and Phool Singh Meena surrounded by their own partymen

Udaipur: Home Minister GulabchandKataria and Udaipurvillagers, Phool Singh Meena MLA has become more threatened by his own leaders than Congress in his constituency. This time, in Mewar, the current BJP MLAs from Udaipur-city and rural areas are facing the challenge in their own party. After



getting the ticket from the city to the MLA Kataria, DalpatSurana stopped the JanataSena and decided to contest the election in front of Kataria. State President of Namo Vichar Manch Shekhawat manch is also opposing Kataria. Against the second and rural MLA PhulasinhMeena, Harish Meena, who is a BJP contender, has opened a front.

Congress President does not control the speech of Kataria

City District Congress President Gopal Sharma also said that while opening a front against Home Minister GulabchandKataria, Kataria has lost control over his speech. As soon as the MLA candidate was declared, Katariya used to use unrealistic words like 'I will put acid in the root of Congress and win 28 seats in the division ...' to the workers, for whom the public will not forgive them. Sharma said that Kataria's bitter words and devious tricks of destruction, the black-looking conspiracy the opposite seems to be doing. Sharma said Kataria has said to the people of his own party that 'your vote is not needed, putting your vote in the well ...', then Kataria will now go to the people to vote for the people.

#### Congress to field both generals in Raj poll war

New Delhi: In a strategic move to signal preparedness the Congress decided to field both its generals - former Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and state chief Sachin Pilot — in the Rajasthan poll war on December 7. Appearing together in the capital to welcome into Congress fold Harish Chandra Meena, the sitting BJP LokSabha member from Dausa, both Gehlot and Pilot said they will be contesting the upcoming Rajasthan assembly elections

"I will fight elections and so will Mr. Sachin Pilot," Gehlot, Congress General Secretary organisation, announced enthusiastically.Pilot, seated close to Gehlot, first sufficed to smile at his senior's remarks but later decided to corroborate him.

"On the directions of Congress President Rahul Gandhi and on the request of Shri Ashok Gehlot I will be contesting the upcoming assembly elections," said the 41 year old Rajasthan Congress President.Known to be daggers drawn in state politics. Gehlot and Pilot wore a semblance of cordiality today denying any kind of rift.But asked which seat Pilot would contest, Gehlot said seats would be declared later but shortly.

"For today it should be enough of news for you that both of us will be contesting," said Gehlot, known for his political shrewdness.Notwithstanding happy vibes between the two politicians, Congress insiders today said the move to field both was sure to intensify the race for chief minister ship of the state should Congress win on December 11, as is widely anticipated.
