WORKERS' FEED BACK: THE MAIN CRITERIA FOR CANDIDATE SELECTION

Jaipur: State Congress President Sachin Pilot on Sunday said the panel of probable party candidate for upcoming Lok Sabha elections will be made on suggestions received from workers and office bearers. Thereafter, the panel will be submitted to the Central Election Committee of AICC. Addressing a joint meeting of state executive members and office bearers, MLAs, district chiefs, and frontal and department chiefs, Pilot said, "The party will review all the lacunas in the assembly elections and will ensure that the way rebel candidates affected the elections does not happen

again. A true congressman will abide by the decision of AICC chief Rahul Gandhi and looking to which all should contribute to support party candidate." He said in February, Seva Dal national meet will be held in Ajmer, which will be attended by Gandhi, and thereafter, a Youth Congress meeting will be held in March at Udaipur, and like of other departments and frontal organizations, where Gandhi will be invited. Pilot said immediate decisions were taken on suggestions received during the meeting held for Lok Sabha elections related to farmers, jobs, water, and electricity.

"After the assembly session, the ministers, besides their constituency, will visit districts of which they are in charge and work to resolve problems after discussing with workers and office bearers," he said. He added that the government will complete development works on suggestions received from party assembly candidates. Soon the Constitution of a block and booth units at the district level will be completed and important responsibilities will be given. AICC general secretary and in charge, Rajasthan, Avinash Pande said, "In view of the Lok Sabha polls, a five-

member selection committee will be constituted at the state level. Similarly, such committees will also be made at the district level. The programmes given by AICC will be completed in a given time frame such as training of EVM machines and at the district level by project Shakti teams." Chief minister Ashok Gehlot said Congress is fighting against the fascist powers and for that, the working has to be changed by strengthening the lower level of the organization. "The state government in coordination with the party organization will take all the decisions. The district Congress com-

mittees in consensus with the MLAs and block committees should get a proposal passed and submit to the government so that they can be redressed immediately," he said. Till date, 14 lakh people were benefitted from the pension but after the government's decision the number now has increased to 64 lakhs, said Gehlot. "The state party organization should soon call a representative meet so that important suggestions can be received, which will help in taking the decision in the interest of public," the chief minister said.

Google to verify political ads in India

New Delhi: As India gears up for the Lok Sabha elections, Google on Tuesday announced an updated election ad that will provide comprehensive information about who is purchasing these on Google platforms and how much money is being spent.

The updated election ads policy will require advertisers to provide a "pre-certificate" issued by the Election Commission of India (ECI) or anyone authorised by the ECI, for each ad they wish to run.

Google said it will verify the identity of advertisers before their election ads run on its platforms.

The advertiser verification process will begin on February 14 and begin enforcing the policy from February 20.

The company would also introduce an India-specific "Political Advertising Transparency" report and searchable "Political Ads Library" in March.

"The ads that will be covered in the Political Advertising Transparency Report and Ads Library are ads for Lok Sabha Elections 2019 that feature a political party, political candidate or current member of the Lok Sabha, or any ads that are run by a political party, political candidate or current member of the Lok Sabha," said Chetan Krishnaswamy, Director-Public Policy, Google India.

Joshi unanimously elected Speaker

Jaipur: CP Joshi was unanimously elected speaker of the 15th Rajasthan legislative assembly on Wednesday. Chief minister Ashok Gehlot proposed Joshi's name and it was seconded by leader of opposition Gulab Chand Kataria.

Joshi, 68, the former Union minister who was also the state unit president of Congress, was elected from Nathdwara constituency in the assembly elections held last month.

Deputy chief minister Sachin Pilot also proposed Joshi's name which was seconded by former chief minister Vasundhara Raje. Deputy leader of opposition in the assembly

Rajendra Rathore, independent MLAs Mahadev Singh Khandela and Kanti Prasad, CPI(M) MLA Balwan Poonia, and BSP MLA Rajendra Singh Gudha also proposed Joshi's name. Congress' Mahesh Joshi, independents Alok Beniwal and Babu Lal Nagar, CPI(M)'s Giridhar Lal and Rashtriya Lok Tantrik Party's Hanuman Beniwal seconded Joshi's name.

Gehlot congratulated Joshi on behalf of the House, noting that Joshi's ties with the assembly go back 38 years.

In his congratulatory speech, Kataria said Joshi's long experience in political life would help him in running the House.

CPI(M)'s Bhagwan Poonia said that the speaker should give members belonging to smaller parties more time to speak in the House as they have won "after defeating the bigger parties". He also raised the issue of allotment of residential houses to some MLAs by the former speaker.

Joshi thanked the members and said the House should debate and discuss issues that concern the people.

He said he hoped members would work together to create "a new Rajasthan".

Kataria leader of opposition

Jaipur: Former home minister and Udaipur MLA Gulab Chand Kataria was on Sunday unanimously elected the leader of opposition in the Rajasthan Legislative Assembly.

The 74-year-year Udaipur legislator will also be sworn in as the pro-tem speaker on Monday for administering oath to the newly elected MLAs in the assembly session beginning January 15. Kataria was elected as the leader of opposition (LOP) during first meeting of the BJP legislators on Sunday.

Raje proposed Kataria's name in the meeting and it was unanimously seconded by the MLAs.

Former parliamentary affairs minister and Churu MLA Rajendra Rathore was nominated as the deputy leader of opposition. Kataria, an eight-time MLA and Rathore, a seven-time MLA, are both known for their articulate and aggressive nature. Their elections suggest that Bharatiya Janata Party high command is keen on developing a second leadership in the state.

Talking to the media after his election as the leader of opposition, Kataria said, "We will play the role of opposition for the next five years and be the voice of people in the state." He said the party will work to rectify shortcomings and try to win all 25 Lok Sabha seats in the state. Union HRD minister and party's poll in-charge for Rajasthan Prakash Javadekar, national spokesperson Sudhanshu Trivedi and party state president Madan Lal Saini were present in the meeting. Kataria has done his post graduation and also holds B Ed and LLB degrees.

Mixed Cell tumor Removed

Udaipur: The mixed germ tumor generally found in the genitals recently found in the middle of the brain of a young man.

Dr. Manoj U Mahajan, oncologists of GBH American Hospital and Neurosurgeon Dr. Ajit Singh carried out the operation. Doctors claim that this kind of case and operation was done for the first time in Southern Rajasthan.

The 16-year-old man from Pali had visited with his family recently with Dr. Manoj Mahajan, a cancer specialist of the GBH Memorial Cancer Hospital. Seeing the young MRI report one month earlier, there was a centimeter tumor in the brain. Because of this, he became unconscious again with a severe headache. There was a problem in walking, speaking and eating. On this, the young man was shown to Dr. Ajit Singh, a neurosurgeon of GBH American Hospital. There, in the reconstituted MRI, the tumor had grown four centimeters from a month earlier report.

The five-centimeter tumor was between the middle of the patient's brain, because of which it was difficult to reach with normal surgery. Between this seriousness, the patient was starting to fill the brain. Even in Mumbai, Ahmedabad, the process of extracting only water was refused by refusing to do its operation. Neurosurgeon Dr. Ajit Singh said that the brain surgery of patient was done for five hours with the experience of AIIMS, Delhi. By keeping the patient's brain stable, it was completely removed by reaching the tumor spreading in the middle of the brain. According to Dr. Manoj U Mahajan, Mix Germ Cell Tumors are commonly found in men and women in the womb in the testicles and in women. This case of getting this tumor in the brain has been barely hundred and fifty hundred in the country so far. The operation of this tumor which is rarely found in the brain is complex due to this. That is why in Mumbai and Ahmedabad, the patient's family refused to do the operation. Dr. Ajit Singh has claimed that the case and its operation in this way was possible for the first time in Southern Rajasthan.
