Commerce faculty exam results declared

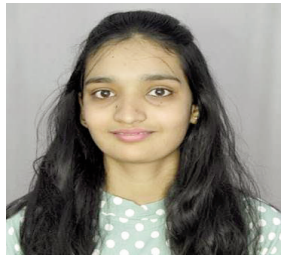
