Jaipur: (Dr.Gopendra Bhatt) Chief Minister Shri Ashok Gehlot has said that Nirogi Rajasthan campaign is a big step towards healthy Rajasthan.

The State Government is working on this initiative to ensure that everybody in the state stays healthy without falling sick. The dream of a healthy Rajasthan would come true soon and Rajasthan would

be a leader in the entire country in the field of health, he said.

Shri Gehlot was addressing the 'Run for Nirogi Rajasthan' on the occasion of the first anniversary of the State Government on Monday morning. He said that the awareness campaign aimed at addressing the all kinds of health-related problems of the common people.

up would be conducted on majority of population for diagnosis of various diseases.

The Chief Minister said that

population control, old-age health problems, woman and adolescent health issues, drug addiction, communicable diseases, non-communicable dis-

eases, vaccination are the major focus areas of the campaign along with preventive healthcare, lifestyle problems and diseases caused by envi-

ronment pollution.

added. The CM said, "During our previous tenure the Chief Minister Free Medicine and Free Diagnostic Test Schemes were launched for everybody. Now, in past one year in the government, scope of both these schemes has been increased by making the increased number of medicines and tests available to the patients. Also, our government banned e-cigarette and hookah bars to save the young generation from such addictions."
