Udaipur: Pacific Dental College & Hospital, Debari, Udaipur in collaboration with Wonder Cement Limited, Nimbahera; Lifescan Healthcare Pvt. Ltd, Pune & IDA Udaipur Branch conducted a mega Oral Cancer Screening and Awareness Programme at Wonder cement premises on 4 February where 3008 patients were screened for oral cancer on a single day at an only venue, and the team was able to establish the National record in India book of records.

Dispose of pending revenue cases over ten years



Bhilwara: District Collector Rajendra Bhatt, in a meeting with the revenue officials of the district in the Collectorate Auditorium, directed that the revenue cases pending for more than ten years should be disposed of by regular hearing. He said this in the context of the instructions given by the Chief Minister through video conference.

The District Collector said that through the video conference before the Panchayat elections, the Chief Minister of the state Mr. Ashok Gehlot had expressed concern over the pending revenue cases and directed to clear the pending revenue cases for more than ten years in 90 days. As per the state government, these cases should be disposed of within the prescribed time and in the next phase, the cases pending for less than ten years.

In the meeting, Additional District Collector (Administration) Rakesh Kumar said that annual verification of the social pension beneficiaries should be done on time. Verify new applications within the stipulated time frame so that the status of auto verification does not come.
