

# Successful treatment of bleeding in the intestine by portal vein stenting in Geetanjali Hospital Udaipur

In Geetanjali Medical College and Hospital, Udaipur, the patients are being treated cautiously continuously, following all the necessary regulations related to the corona pandemic. With the untiring efforts of the Neurosciences team's Neuro Vascular Interventional Radiologist Dr. Sitaram Barath, Gastroenterologist Dr. Dhawal Vyas and team, Dr. Karuna, Dr. Neha, Dr. Manav from the Department of Anesthesia, Cath Lab staff, and CCU staff, successful treatment of the patient suffering from EHPVO (Extrahepatic Portal Vein Obstruction) was done.

The 36-year-old patient, a resident of Pratapggarh, said that for a few months, blood flow also began to occur during bowel movements, due to which he was unable to perform his daily activities such as dizziness, inability to stand and walk all the time, since the patient is from profession He is a barber, because of this disease he was not able to do anything for his livelihood. After suffering greatly increased, the disease went to the local hospital to be shown again; seeing the patient's condition, the local doctor of Pratapggarh advised to go to Geetanjali Hospital, Udaipur from all the latest facilities.

What was the issue?  
Dr. Sitaram Barath told that the patient came to Geetanjali Hospital with the problem of blood coming with stool, endoscopy,

and CT of the patient by Gastroenterologist Dr. Dhawal Vyas. Scanned Examination found that some small veins had swollen in the small intestine, mainly because of the blockage in the main vein called the portal vein and the side branches opened. Due to the increased pressure in the collateral veins, blood flow was happening, and the main vein was closed.

The obstruction was opened by lever stenting of the main portal vein by Dr. Barth, which started the blood's normal flow. It is known as EHPVO (Extrahepatic portal vein obstruction). This disease is generally sporadic.

The patient is now completely disease-free and has been discharged after seven days. For your Information, Geetanjali Hospital is a multi-super specialty hospital. It is fully available to all the patients who come to each specialty because all the state-of-the-art facilities are available under one roof so that the complex operation is complicated. And the procedures are being done continuously by skilled doctors. **Bhilwara:** Chief Minister Mr. Ashok Gehlot said that the state government would give full encouragement to the district milk producers cooperative associations to promote the dairy sector in the state. He said that agriculture and animal husbandry is the mainstay of livelihood in rural areas. Every possible step will be taken to strengthen the dairy sector to make more employment opportunities available to the youth.

Shri Gehlot was addressing the foundation stone laying ceremony of the state-of-the-art milk processing plant at Bhilwara District Milk Producers' Cooperative Federation at the cost of about Rs 75 crore through a video conference from the Chief Minister's residence. To be ready by August 2022, the plant will have a capacity of 5 lakh liters per day.



The Chief Minister said that to provide remunerative prices to the farmers and empower them financially, the State Government emphasizes food processing. Now farmers do not need the land conversion of land up to 10 hectares after setting up a food processing unit in the state. He said that there is a lot of scope for expanding the dairy sector in the state. It will be our effort to make milk production, collection, and marketing work faster. Saras Dairy achieves a prominent place in the country.

Shri Gehlot said that in strengthening the country's cooperative movement, the former Prime Minister, self. Jawaharlal Nehru had been a significant contributor. The result of his foresight is that our country, dependent on other countries, could move towards being self-reliant. Former Prime Minister Late Indira Gandhi's efforts led to significant innovations in the country, such as the Green Revolution and the White Revolution, which enabled the country to become self-sufficient in food grains and made incredible progress in the field of dairy. He started a revolution in the dairy sector. Also recalled Varghese Kurian's contribution.

Agriculture Minister Shri Lalchand Kataria said that in time of Corona, farmers and herders are supporting the economy of the country and the state. He said that youth's increasing interest in the traditional field of farming and animal husbandry is a good sign.

Gopalan Minister Pramod Bhaya said that despite the economic crisis caused by Covid-19, Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot is continuously taking welfare decisions in farmers and livestock farmers' interest.

Cooperative Minister Shri Udai Lal Anjana said that there are about 33 thousand cooperative institutions in Rajasthan, out of which about 15,000 are related to the dairy sector. She said that the participation of women in the dairy sector has also increased considerably.

Chairman of the National Dairy Development Board, Mr. Dilip Rath, said that remarkable work is being done in the field of dairy development in Rajasthan. He said that it is a welcome decision to give 2 rupees per liter grant to cattle rearers under the Chief Minister Milk Producer Sambal Yojana. He said that NDDB would cooperate fully in the dairy development of Rajasthan. The progress made by Bhilwara Dairy Federation in milk collection and marketing is commendable. For this, this association has also received the Excellence Award. While giving the presentation, Executive Director of NDDB, Mr. Arun Raste, said that milk collection in Rajasthan has increased by 5.6 percent annually in the last ten years. He said that 18 thousand 500 new small and marginal milk producing members would get livelihood from the new plant. Bhilwara Milk Producers Association Chairman and MLA Shri Ramlal Jat said that this new plant to be set up with the cooperation of NDDB would further strengthen the Bhilwara Dairy. Due to environment-friendly, power-saving, and low cooling costs, this plant will give milk producers a better price. Minister of State for Agriculture and Animal Husbandry Shri Bhajan Lal Jatav thanked.

Mr. KL Swamy, Managing Director of Rajasthan Cooperative Dairy Federation, gave a welcome address. The presidents and officials of various District Milk Producer Cooperative Associations, MLAs, other public representatives, officers, and representatives of the dairy sector connected to the program through video conference.
