Rajasthan gets pride in 'Big Butterfly Month'

Udaipur: These days, while the butterfly month i.e. "Big Butterfly Month" is going on to take the campaign of counting, understanding, and conservation of butterflies across the country, two environmental scientists working for the conservation of environment and biodiversity has succeeded in finding two new species of butterflies in Rajasthan.

Dr. Dharmendra Khandal, renowned environmental scientist and field biologist of Tiger Watch, Rajasthan, and environmental scientist Dr. Satish Sharma working for biodiversity conservation in South Rajasthan planted these two butterflies in the outer part of the Ranthambore tiger project area of Sawai Madhopur in the state. Have discovered the species. Dr. Satish Sharma said that in the outer part of the project area, two new butterflies named Deccan Tri-Color Pied Flat (Koladalia Indrani Indra) and Spotted they have discovered a small Flat (Sarangesa Purendra Sati) in the beautiful butterflies of Rajasthan. Both these butterflies are members of the Hesperinid family.



Dr. Sharma pointed out that the upper surface of the Koladalia Indrani Indra butterfly's wings is golden yellow on which there are four-four semi-transparent white spots

with a black border on the outer core of the first pair of wings. The other two or two small areas remain. The back couple has dark spots on the wings. The torso, belly, and legs of this butterfly are yellow, and the eyes are black. The wing cores are black with white spots at minute intervals. There are more white spots on the hind wings. This butterfly is known in Bengal, Kerala, Himachal Pradesh, North-Eastern India, Chhattisgarh, Jammu and Kashmir, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, and Uttarakhand. After this discovery, Rajasthan has also joined its distribution area. The butterfly named Dr. Sharma Sarangesa Purendra Sati looks very attractive with a scattered white spot pattern on brown-black color. Its rings are white but have a blackish top. This butterfly is found in Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, and Uttarakhand. Presently this butterfly is present in Sawai Madhopur, Karauli, Bundi, and Tonk districts. Dr. Khandal said that rainy time is suitable for watching the movements of both butterflies. There are plants like Tridax Procumbens, Lepidagethis cristata, Lepidagethis hamiltonian, etc. where they are more likely to be found. He said that these new butterflies' research records had been published in issue 24 (2) of the Indian General of Environmental Science.

Sukhadia University to become the first University to use artificial intelligence

Udaipur: Mohanlal Sukhadia University will be the first University to experiment with Artificial Intelligence under the leadership of Vice-Chancellor Prof. America Singh. Under this, a robot will be prepared to perform thermal scanning outside the University's administrative building and answer the student's and visitors' questions.



University spokesman Dr. Kunjan Acharya said that the newly appointed Vice-Chancellor had favored Artificial Intelligence since the beginning. Besides, he has spoken of innovation in the University using science and technology on every occasion. In this sequence, the Vice-Chancellor has prepared an action plan for buying robots. He will meet experts from various high-tech companies in New Delhi on Monday and talk to them for technical testing cooperation. The Vice-Chancellor intends that a robot be deployed outside the administrative building of the University, which not only arranges for thermal scanning and sanitization but also to greet the visitors and to respond to whom they want to meet and what kind of work it is. Vice-Chancellor Prof Singh will soon take steps in this direction after meeting and consulting technical experts. The Vice-Chancellor said that Sukhadia University wants to advance employment-oriented education, hence the research work related to Artificial Intelligence. This will be an important step towards becoming a popular example of innovation and incubation. The Vice-Chancellor said that all the courses would be tested according to the new education policy. All possible changes will also be made to include technology and artificial intelligence.

Cabinet Approves Haryana Orbital Rail Corridor Project

(Estimated completion cost of the project is ~ Rs. 5,617 crore and it is proposed to be completed in 5 years)

New Delhi: (Hritu Sodhi) The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, has given its approval to the Haryana Orbital Rail Corridor Project from Palwal to Sonapat via Sohna-Manesar-Kharakhauda.

This Rail Line will start from Palwal and end at existing Harsana Kalan station (On Delhi-Ambala section). This will also give connectivity enroute to existing Patli Station (On Delhi-Rewari line), Sultanpur station (On Garhi Harsaru-Farukhnagar Line) and Asaudha Station (On Delhi Rohtak Line). The project will be implemented by Haryana Rail Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (HRIDC), a Joint Venture company set up by Ministry of Railways with Government of Haryana. The project will have joint participation of Ministry of Railways, Government of Haryana and private stakeholders. Estimated completion cost of the project is Rs. 5,617 crore. The project is likely to be completed in 5 years.

Benefits- The districts of Palwal, Nuh, Gurugram, Jhajjar and Sonapat districts of Haryana will be benefitted through this rail line.

This will facilitate diversion of traffic not meant for Delhi thus decongesting NCR and will help in developing mul-

timodal logistics hubs in Haryana State sub-region of NCR. It will provide high-speed seamless connectivity of this region to Dedicated Freight Corridor network resulting in reduction of cost and time of transportation for EXIM traffic from NCR to ports of India, making exports of goods more competitive.

This efficient transport corridor along with other initiatives will provide enabling infrastructure to attract multinational industries to set up manufacturing units to fulfil the 'Make in India' mission.

The project will connect unserved areas of the state of Haryana, thereby boosting economic and social activities in Haryana State. This multipurpose transport project will also facilitate affordable and faster commuter travel, long distance travel in different directions from Gurugram and the industrial regions of Manesar, Sohna, Farukhnagar, Kharakhauda and Sonapat. Approximately 20,000 passengers each day will be travelling through this line and 50 Million Tonnes goods traffic would also be carried out every year.

The Orbital Rail Corridor from Palwal to Sonapat by passing Delhi is a crucial infrastructure project for sustainable development of the National Capital Region and to decongest existing Indian Railway network in Delhi area.

The alignment of this project is adjacent to the western peripheral (Kundi-Manesar-Palwal) Expressway and has been under consideration for some time. The project will have connectivity with all the existing Railway routes originating from Delhi and passing through Haryana State as well as with the Dedicated Freight Corridor network.

Raghuvver Meena Udaipur gets Birth in CWC

JEE-Main -2020 Results

Ten students of Alan Bhilwara achieved more than 99 percentile



Pune: Students of Allen Career Institute have once again outperformed in the results of the Engineering Entrance Examination JEE-Main-2020, released by the National Training Agency (NTA).

Ankur Porwal, Academic Head of Allen Career Institute Bhilwara, said that there are ten students of Alan Bhilwara who have scored 99 percentile or more NTA.

Besides, 24 students have obtained 95 percentiles or more. With this, 40 students of the institute have qualified for JEE Advanced.

It is noteworthy that All India Rank is also to be released jointly based on the JEE-Mains of January and September examination results.

Two and a half lakh students will be included in JEE-Advanced. The exam will be held on September 27, whose registration has started. In JEE-Main September, 8 lakh 58 thousand 273 students were registered this year. This online exam was released in 12 shifts.

On the basis of JEE-Mains, about 2 lakh 50 thousand students selected as top candidates have been declared eligible for appearing in the JEE-Advanced examination, in which JEE-Mains cut-off of general category 90.3765335, the cut-off of EWS category 70.2435518, OBC NCL category cut-off 72.8887969, SC's cut-off has been 50.1760245, ST's cut-off 39.0696101 and PWD class cut-off has been 0.0618524.

These two and a half lakh students include 1,01,250 students of general category, 25 thousand general EWS, 67500 of OBC, 37500 of SC, and 18750 students of ST.
