

Successful surgery of complex enterocutaneous fistula in PMCH

Udaipur: A successful operation of the 24-year-old Penta Ram Garasia complex of enterocutaneous fistula (was conducted at Udaipurat Pacific Medical College and Hospital. Surgeons Dr. KC Vyas, Dr. Gaurav Wadhawan, Dr. Dhawal Sharma, Dr. Prakash Audichya of the Department of Anesthesia, Ajay Chaudhary, and Sandeep carried out this operation, which lasted for two hours.

24-year-old Penta Ram, a resident of Gogunda, was upset about stomach pain and leakage of stool due to intestinal injury due to a fall from a tree two years ago. Due to this problem, it became difficult for him to leave the house and go to work due to the clothes getting dirty repeatedly. Penta Ram's family showed him several places, complaining of excretion from the stomach, but to no avail.

Disturbed by this disease and suffering, the family brought him to the Pacific Hospital at Bedla, where he showed him to surgeon KC Vyas. After examining the patient, it was found that it has a complex enterocutaneous fistula, which is possible to be treated by operation only.

Surgeon Dr. Dhawal Sharma said that the operation was very complicated due to weakness and anemia due to Penta Ram because the intestines were stuck and torn in many places in the patient's stomach, which were separated and the stool passage was closed.

This operation was done free of cost under the Bhamashah Health Insurance Scheme. The patient and his family thanked PMCH chairman Rahul Agarwal, all doctors, management, nursing personnel, and staff.
