

## Rajasthan created history by winning the 11th National Kudo and the first Federation Kudo Cup-2021, winning the double title



**Udaipur:** 109 medals in the 6-day 11th All India National Kudo Championship 2021 organized under the joint aegis of the Union Sports Ministry and the National Kudo Federation at the College of

Engineering Green Hills, Sonal city, Himachal Pradesh from September 2, and 136 medals in the first Kudo Cup-2021. Rajasthan has created history by capturing the double championship.

Shihan Rajkumar Menaria (6 Degree Black Belt Japan), Joint Secretary of Kudo India and President of Rajasthan Kudo, told that 235-member team Rajasthan participated in more than 200 weight cate-

gories of Sub Junior, Junior, Cadet, Senior and Veteran categories. In the 11th All India National Kudo Championship of the Ministry, the Rajasthan Kudo team under the leadership of coach Sensay Vipash Menaria won 58 gold, 31 silver, and 20 bronze medals totaling 109 medals and 71 gold, 32 silver, and 31 bronze in the first Kudo Federation Cup-2021, made history by winning the 'Hour All Champion Trophy' of both the competitions. More than 1500 women, men, boys, and girls from 25 states and 3 union territories participated in this 6-day tour-

nament. Menaria told that after knowing that Kudo has been authorized by the Union Ministry of Sports, now a school and college students will get its benefit in every field.

Himachal Pradesh Sports Minister Dr. Rajiv Sehgal said that the old art of our country has come in a new form in the form of Kudo martial art.

Hanshi Mehul Vora, President of the International Kudo Federation of India (KIFI) and Director of the tournament, said that in both these Grand Championships, Team Rajasthan has proved that they are working hard for the

Kudo Rajasthan players and have won international medals in India. Has ability. We have high hopes for Kudo Rajasthan.

In the closing ceremony, the President of Kudo Rajasthan and senior coach of Team Rajasthan, Shihan Rajkumar Menaria, the official referee, the judge, and the members of the organizing committee were blessed by the spiritual guru Baba Amardev of Himachal Pradesh and wished them a bright future. On this occasion, Menaria, Secretary Renshi Pritam Sen, and Team Rajasthan were felicitated by

presenting Team Champions Trophy. The Chairman of Kudo India and Bollywood star Akshay Kumar could not attend the event due to the death of his mother.

Shihan Menaria told that in the championship trophy of the competition, Udaipur has 33 gold, 17 silver, and 13 bronze, Bikaner 16 gold, 13 silver, and 14 bronze, Jodhpur 26 gold, 13 silver and 8 bronze, Alwar 17 gold, 13 Silver and 8 Bronze, Sri Ganganagar won 23 Gold, 10 Silver and 5 Bronze, Sirohi won 1 Silver and 1 Bronze, Jalore won 14 Gold, 3 Silver, and 3 Bronze medals.

Three senior judges of Rajasthan, Shahan Rajkumar Menaria, Renshi Pritam Sen, and Sensay Vipash Menaria were awarded A category based on their performance. Manju Menaria, the operator of the Chartered Accountant firm of Udaipur, was honored as the National Referee B.
