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VP SAYS 'TECHNOLOGY SHOULD NOT EXCLUDE DIFFERENTLY-ABLED PEOPLE', CALLS FOR EFFORTS INTO MAKING ACCESSIBLE TECHNOLOGY

The Vice President, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu today called for a change in people's mindset towards the Divyangjan community or the differently-abled and asserted that it is the responsibility of the government and society at large to prevent any kind of discrimination against them. He stressed the need for creating an environment for them to

thrive and excel. "They do not need our sympathy, they rightfully deserve every opportunity to develop to their full potential", he added.

The Vice President was speaking at the National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Intellectual Disabilities (NIEPID) in Hyderabad during his visit to the institute. Shri Naidu appre-

ciated NIEPID for its work in empowering persons with Intellectual Disability and their families.

Underlining that accessibility is an important area of intervention for the differently-abled, Shri Naidu noted the positive impact of the 'Accessible India' campaign and called for more interventions in the areas of environ-

ment, transport, information and communication systems.

Emphasising the need to make public spaces, transport and private buildings more accessible, Shri Naidu said that it was also important to sensitise teachers and non-teaching staff in schools to the needs of the differently-abled children.

Suggesting that it was important "to ensure that tech-

nology does not exclude differently-abled people", he urged national institutions and universities in India to accelerate their work relating to accessible smart technology.

Shri Naidu called for all-round efforts to make the Divyangjan people financially independent by identifying and honing their skills from a young age. Reminding that the core

values of India are those of 'Sarvejana Sukhino Bhavantu' and 'Vasudhaiva

Kutumbakam', he called upon everyone - including the government, private sector, civil society and families to take initiatives to empower the differently-abled and fulfil their duty or 'dharma'.

The Vice President stressed the importance of

early detection and identification of children at risk for disability conditions and called for opening up more such centres such as the newly established Cross-Disability Early Intervention Service Center (CDEISC) in all states. He also suggested to NIEPID to have a tie-up with institutions like the Centre for Cellular and Molecular Biology for early

detection of disability risk among children. He underlined the need for counselling parents in case of early detection of the risk for disabilities among children. Shri Naidu suggested more collaboration between organisations such as NIEPID and Centre For Cellular And Molecular Biology (CCMB) for early detection and prevention of genetic disorders.

Kalpana Pishach also depicts the ancient time's torture tradition and its social effects

Kalpana Pishach, was written in 1975 by Rizwan Zahir Usman Sahab. For this play, he has also been awarded for the Devilala Samar Natya play-writing, Rizwan Zahir Usman Sahab was a modern theatre artist whose plays were basically related to the burning questions of social problems and political issues. According to him, Drama is not just a form of entertainment, it also has a message, and it also has a clear purpose in favour of the sophistication of human senses.

In this play, the landlord is named Pisach and Kalpana has been referred to as the dream of freedom from all of the exploitation and torture the poor people suffer.

These old conservative tra-



ditions have made the humans thoughts like animals. In that era, not only the poor people were tortured by powerful men but they also rape and molest women to show off their post, prestige and splendour.

Those rich people consider themselves as, all in all, God.

Time by time, the way of torture kept changing. People have also raised their voices against these crimes but nonetheless, this torture is a part and parcel of this society. This play has been directed

by Sunil Tank who has kept this play alive by selecting the right cast with neutral direction. The vision behind presenting this play is that every individual can feel the pain of the torture, raise their voice against such acts and aid the people to live freedom life.

This play is an overwhelming story of the people being tortured and behaving like an animal.

By presenting this play, I want to show the real face of society in ancient times plays

According to the news, the NSD has tried to portray it but they could not succeed. It is considered to be quite difficult to be portrayed despite being a powerful play. Shailender Sharma, the close friend, and disciple of Rizwan Zahir Usman Sahab, who is having over 50 years of experience doing the

theatre and has also been part of this play in the past, has played the main role in this play.

After 40 years this "Kalpana Pishach" play has been depicted and directed by Team Natya Sanstha. This Sanstha has also been founded in Udaipur in 1970 by Shailender Sharma, Rizwan Zahir Usman Sahab, and his friends. Till then Sanstha has portrayed multiple plays that are based on social issues and real facts of life. And still, this Sanstha is coming up with new projects which depict the burning and social issues.

The play was prepared in a presentation-oriented theatrical workshop. It was presented in the Shilpgram auditorium named "Darpan". Pressure grouting should be done

Udaipur. By banning fishing, control of aquatic vegetation through the biological method and pressure grouting should be done on the walls of the lake. The above ideas emerged in the public dialogue organized after the Sunday Shramdaan.

Tej Shankar Paliwal, a former member of the Lake Development Authority, said that many lakes had grown aquatic vegetation in Pichola and Fateh Sagar. By banning the killing of fish, the aquatic vegetation can be controlled if the fish are left eating the aquatic vegetation. Even after spending several crores of rupees, aquatic vegetation has not been controlled.

Environmental expert Nand Kishore Sharma said that aquatic vegetation keeps changing its form with the change in every season. To maintain the water quality of drinking water lakes and to keep the solid lakes sewer free, pressure grouting will have to be done on the walls

of the lake so that the water of the lake can be saved and kept sewer free.

Drupad Singh, a lake lover, said that some aquatic plants are injurious to human health, so only biological methods can provide relief. Before the dialogue, floating plastic bags, huge quantities of bread, rotten street food items, water liquor bottles, and aquatic weeds were taken out from the lake area of Pichola. Local residents, including Ramesh Chandra Gehlot, Drupad Singh Chohan Nand, and Kishore Sharma Tej Shankar Paliwal, participated in Shramdaan.
