Udaipur: Passenger facilities are being developed and expanded by the Indian Railways in the country's progress. In this episode of development, in the presence of Shri Ashwini Vaishnav, Minister of Railways, Communications, Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India, present at the function, on 31.07.2022, at Badi Sadri railway station, the gauge conversion of Badi Sadri-Mavli railway section was done. In the program organized at Rewa railway station, there was a dignified presence of MP-Rewa, Shri Janardan Mishra, MLA-Rewa Shri Rajendra Shukla, and Leader of Opposition West Bengal Legislative Assembly, Shri Shubhendu Adhikari at Siuri station.

Shri Ashwini Vaishnav, Minister of Railways, Communications, Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India, said that Indian Railways today is moving towards a new direction under the leadership of Shri Narendra Modi. He saluted this heroic land of Rajasthan and praised the local MP for the development of railways in this area and the strong lead-

ers in Rewa and West Bengal. Talking about the redevelopment of stations, he said that the stations are being built with a plan for the next 50 years. He said that the work of making Udaipur City Railway world class is not only in discussion now, but its tenders have been issued, and work will be started after finalizing this tender in August. Shri Ashwini Vaishnav announced on this occasion to make Chittorgarh station a world-class station. He directed the officials to prepare the background and design, keeping in mind the sacrifice, sacrifice, and courage of the land of the heroes. In this, guidelines were also provided for the participation of public representatives and residents. Along with this, the Railway Minister, taking immediate action on the demand of the public representatives for two trips during the day of the Badi Sadri-



Udaipur rail service, announced that it would be made two trips daily from August 15.

Today, the cleanliness system in the railways is excellent, and the trains are performing well in maintaining the time. Thanks to the railway officials, including General Manager Vijay Sharma, for completing the

Udaipur-Himmatnagar project and demanded the Railway Minister to start it soon so that this route can be directly connected to Mumbai and required completion of the proposed survey of Devgarh-Bar at the earliest.

MP-Chittaurgarh, Shri Chandra Prakash Joshi, in his address, thanked Shri Ashwini Vaishnav, Railway Minister, for visiting the railway service in a big way and said that the extensive Sadi-Neemuch rail

line, which was found after three years of struggle, if its work is completed by 2023, then this area will be directly connected to Mumbai. He said that the creation of new lines, doubling, broad gauge, and electrification had been done very fast on the railways. Due to the doubling work of the Ajmer-Udaipur route, trains like Rajdhani and Shatabdi are likely to come to this area. The Railway Minister has fulfilled the demands of all the passenger facilities related to this area, thanking him for this. The daily commuters, business people, and students would benefit from this railway service's start. Shri Chandra Prakash Joshi requested the Railway Minister name this railway service Bhamashah Express.

Welcoming the dignitaries, Shri Vijay Sharma, General Manager, North Western Railway, said that after the establishment of this section in broad gauge, this area would have direct rail transport connectivity with other regions of India. Along with this, Rewa-Udaipur City-Rewa weekly

exceptional and Sealdah-Saudi-Sealdah MEMU rail service was also started through video link.

On this occasion, Chief Administrative Officer/Construction of North Western Railway Mr. Brijesh Kumar Gupta, Divisional Railway Manager-Ajmer Mr. Naveen Kumar Parasuramka, along with railway officers and employees, were also present in the program organized at Badi Sadri station.

Mahatma Gandhi's best example of spiritual politics - Prof. Vajpayee

Udaipur: In today's political situation, the need for spiritual politics is felt strongly because its lack removes us from the values of life. Mahatma Gandhi is the best example of spiritual politics, and we should learn from him and strengthen today's political situation and values.

This was stated by the Vice Chancellor of Atal Bihari Vajpayee University, Bilaspur, Prof. Arun Diwakar Nath Vajpayee, as the keynote speaker in the Mohanlal Sukhadia Memorial Lecture organized every year by Mohanlal Sukhadia University. He spoke on the subject of 'spiritual politics' at the university guest house auditorium on Monday. He said there is a need to break the whirlwinds and tremors of realism, and present-day politics cannot do this work. Only spiritual politics can do this work. Spiritual politics is not seen in today's politics because it is based on religion and region. He said that Gandhi's politics is the best example of spiritual politics. He said that Mahatma Gandhi, through politics with spiritual experiments, set the sun of the British dynasty, which was considered the enormous power in the world. The politics of Bal Gangadhar Tilak, Vivekananda, Shankaracharya, and Tagore were also full of spirituality. Only then do they awaken the spirit of patriotism along with spirituality. He said that today's politics take recourse to religion, whereas there is a beautiful difference between religion and spirituality which we can hardly understand. He said that in a program at Cambridge University, a professor asked if Gandhi had not been there, would India not have been independent, would India have been in the same situation? The answer to him was that India would have got freedom but would have it. Like other nations, we got after total bloodshed and war. Gandhi is the father of the politics of peace, prosperity, and harmony seen in India today. He



said that spirituality is found in books. It is seen in serials on television, but it is completely lacking in real life. He needs to find her today.

If spirituality comes into life, democratic values will also be strong, and today's politics will also be strong and pure. He said that spirituality is not the name of any ordinary thing. It is not even the name of the idea. When we mention the soul while doing research, research, which is also indicative of cultural values. If the nature of the soul and its characteristics are brought into life, then it will be spirituality. He said that the quality of eternity is the paramount quality of spirituality. He is all-pervasive. It lives before and after we are born. Citing the example of DS Kothari, a renowned scientist from Udaipur, he said that his scientific specialties and research included spirituality, just as the soul is in harmony with the Supreme Soul. We need to look for the same thing.

He said that urgency is part of personality and functioning, but universal of all time is what makes our functioning strong. Makes our thoughts and thoughts strong and public welfare. He expressed concern and said we were taught many incidents related to our great men in history. How many wars

Rani Durgavati won was not mentioned. The loss of a fight was discussed everywhere. Referring to Maharana Pratap, he said that learning and understanding from such great men are necessary. Our new generation will be able to learn in the struggle from their vitality and struggle.

He said that today's generation is entangled in studies and marks table. We have to develop spirituality in the new generation. We see in the numbers and tell who got how many marks, but after getting those marks, how much spirituality could be developed through their values and life culture would have been better if it was known.

The Chief Guest of the program, Vice Chairman, Rajasthan State Higher Education Council, Prof. Dariyav Singh Chundawat, said that the politics of Mohanlal Sukhadia Ji is an example of the best politics; he has set new paradigms of development that are challenging to see in today's politics.
