Don't conquer the soul by defeating the karma goal of suicide - Samkit Muni

Bhilwara: Stronger than pride is the power of humility. Due to pride, the mighty Ravana, who lifted Mount Kailash, could not lift a bow, while Rama, having the power of humility and love, lifted it. Where love and humility are needed, strength does not work. These views were expressed by Shramanasangh Advisor Sumatprakashji M.S. Pragya Maharishi Dr. Samkitmuniji, M.S. Expressed on Wednesday at Shanti Bhavan as part of the regular Chaturmasik discourse.

He said that even after having the ability to get auspicious, those who start doing inauspicious deeds are ruined by their hands like Ravana. It is time to come to the shrine, but even after the time is favorable, those who are engaged in inauspicious work are "Ravana". Munishree said that even after having the ability to get auspicious, sometimes suicidal goals are scored. Introspect that we are not doing a lot of harm to ourselves by defeating the soul and winning karma by committing suicide goals.

They are not doing the work of winning the one they want to defeat. Revered Samkit Muniji M.S. Said that while doing the work of protecting our soul, if we are collecting the burden of karma for the soul, then it will be suicidal. To harm oneself at one's own hands is suicidal.

He said that if you want to tell someone, show the power of forgiveness, not anger, but we trust anger more. People praise those who tell the power of forgiveness in moments of anger. Instead of telling the power of humility in the moments of pride, the world is trying to increase the power of sin. While doing this, man becomes like an animal and on telling the power of religion, human becomes God. While stating the need to listen more than speaking, Munishree said that the first condition for a speaker is to become one's own for the front and the one in front to be one's own. If this is not the case, the listener feels that the speaker is not speaking. Through words, you can make a stranger your own and you can also make yourself a stranger. Sometimes a heavy price has to be paid for not choosing the words correctly. If you start telling someone using abusive words, then how will the relationship improve. At the beginning of the religious assembly, the vocalist Jaywant Muniji M.S. Presented the song "The jeweler of your life became yourself". Inspirational Bhavantmuniji M.S. Also found support.

Samkit Muniji M.S. Said that it is the service of Jinshasan to dedicate oneself to Jinshasan in the morning. There is no need to ask anyone, the rise of my sin or virtue is going on. As soon as you wake up in the morning, there is a feeling of counting the Navkar mantra, then if you feel like doing virtue and looking at the face in the mirror, then understand it is the rise of sin. He said that he is a virtuous person who, when he wakes up in the morning, looks at the words and scriptures.
