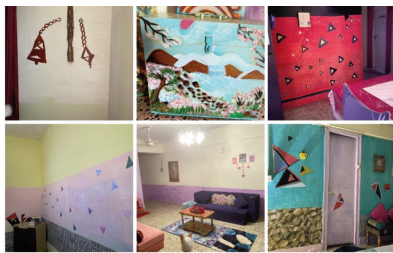
Rajasthan Information Center Mumbai rejuvenated

Rajasthan Information Center Mumbai office was established in 1989.
