## UDAIPUR : ALL SET FOR CONVOCATIONS

### 16th Convocation of M.P.U.A.T.

#### 954 degrees will be awarded at the conference

**Udaipur:** The 16th Convocation of Maharana Pratap University of Agriculture and Technology, Udaipur, will be celebrated on Wednesday, December 21, at noon in the Vivekananda Auditorium of M.L.S.U. On this occasion, eminent educationist Prof. S. L. Mehta, Ex-Vice Chancellor M.P.U.A.T., and former Deputy Director General (Agriculture Education), I.C.A.R., will deliver his convocation address. Chancellor Shri Kalraj Mishra will preside over the convocation ceremony.

Vice-Chancellor Ajeet Kumar Karnataka said that our university has been organizing its convocation ceremony on time for more than ten years. Everyone has contributed collectively to ensure the progress of our university. It is a pleasure for us that M.P.U.A.T. has excelled on all fronts. M.P.U.A.T. has the distinction of receiving the Chancellor's Award as the Best University of Rajasthan. The I.C.A.R. ranking also got the 15th rank last year and 51st two years back. Our best performance has also been in village Madar adopted on the Smart Village Initiative of the Governor, as a result of which our works and Madar have

been kept as model villages for all universities.

The Board of Management has approved the degree and gold medals to be awarded at the 16th convocation of the university on December 21. According to this, 954 degrees will be awarded in the convocation, in which 760 undergraduate, 126 postgraduate, and 68 Vidya-Vachaspati degrees will be awarded in the Faculty of Agriculture, Engineering, Community Science, Dairy Technology, and Fisheries. A total of 35 gold medals will be awarded at the ceremony.

13 gold medals at the graduate level, 17 at the post-graduate level, and Ph.D. Level 2 gold medals will be awarded. Apart from this, the Jain Irrigation Medal and Shri Phool Singh Rathore Memorial Medal to one girl student of the Agricultural Engineering Faculty and Chancellor's Gold Medal to Yatharth Sharma, one student of Community Science College, will also be given. As everyone is curious, in this convocation also, girls have won medals; this time, 23 girl students and 12 boys will get gold medals.

In this convocation, 760 graduates, 126 postgraduates, and 68 Ph.D. students will be awarded degrees. Also, 13 undergraduate, 17 postgraduate, and 2 Vidyavachaspati

students will receive gold medals for standing first in the order of merit in their respective subjects and programs. Chancellor's Medal, Jain Irrigation Medal to 1 student, and Shri Phool Singh Rathore Memorial Medal to 1 student will be awarded to Yatharth Sharma College of Community and Applied Sciences.

He said that getting the distinction of being the first winner of the prestigious "Chancellor's Award" based on strict criteria of achievements and innovations in Education and related fields was a significant achievement for us, which gives us the power to work with more energy for the future. Has proven to be a provider.

Last year, all six colleges got the certification from the Indian Council of Agricultural Research, while earlier only three colleges got this certification. As a result of this certification, degree holders from all these colleges will get admission for studies in prestigious higher educational institutions and employment opportunities with higher pay scales in reputed institutions.

This year, the College of Technology and Technology, in the 6th ranking issued by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, after competing among 3,500 colleges, got first in the band 201



to 250. We were the first among the state-funded institutions of Rajasthan. In the same year, four units received ISO 9001 certification, which reflects the high potential in experiential learning.

To give a new base to the courses, the recommendations of B.A.S.M.A. were implemented from 2022-23 for post-graduate and undergraduate courses in agriculture and engineering faculties, whereas, in community science, this process was completed in the year 2021-22. In the direction of making a uniform curriculum in the state, M.P.U.A.T. has recently sent its report to the Honorable Sir with the recommendation to convert Home Science into Community Science. We have also completed a 7-day training program for four batches of program officers of the National Service Scheme established in the Directorate of Student Welfare in To offer a broad base for

Education, research, and dissemination, agreements have been signed with 16 reputed institutions so far this year.

This year, three contracts were signed with the University of Namibia and the University of Western Sydney, Australia, to provide an international format to Education as per the new education policy. Recently five students have gone to Purdue University, U.S.A., for advanced training, and 5 students will go to North Carolina University.

Along with this, a proposal to send three faculty fellows abroad for training has also been approved.

The students excelled in the software and hardware category of the Hackathon competition organized by A.I.C.T.E. and won prizes.

In the same year, the "Sustainable Energy Laboratory" sponsored by DST was established in the Mechanical Department.

### Sukhadia University's 30th convocation on 20th December 2022



**Udaipur:** The 30th convocation of Mohanlal Sukhadia University will be held on Tuesday at 11 am in Vivekananda Auditorium. Chancellor and Governor Kalraj Mishra will distribute gold medals and degrees.

The chief speaker will be Professor Girish Mishra, former Vice-Chancellor of Mahatma Gandhi

Antarrashtriya Hindi Vishwa vidyalaya, Wardha. University spokes person Dr. Kunjan Acharya said that 88 gold medals, 8 chancellor's medals, and 11 sponsor's medals would be awarded in the convocation. The Ph.D. degree will be awarded to 187 people, including 39 in Science, 13 in Commerce, 38 in Social Science, 15 in Earth

Science, 12 in Management, 41 in Humanities, 7 in Law, and 22 in Education. Will be provided. Rehearsal for the convocation ceremony was held on Monday under the leadership of Vice-Chancellor Professor IV Trivedi in Vivekananda Auditorium in which all Deans, Directors, Heads of Departments, BOM members, and other officials.

### Kayasthas will perform a show of strength on 23 September 2022 at Ramlila Maidan



**Udaipur:** The first national convention of the Global Kayastha Conference (GKC), an international organization of Kayastha society, concluded with a vehicle rally on Sunday. The vehicle rally took from Shri Chitragupt Sabha Bhavan to Pratap Gaurav Kendra via various city routes. In the rally, 20 autos were decorated with GKC flags and flags of the great men of Kayastha society. Apart from this, about 50 cars and 20 two-wheelers were included in the rally.

Shri Chitragupt Sabha Bhavan, Global President of GKC, JDU spokesperson Rajeev Ranjan Prasad, Prof. B.P. Bhatnagar, and LN Mathur Flagged off. GKC Global General Secretary Anurag Saxena, National Vice President Dr. Vivek Bhatnagar, District President Dr. Saroj Kumar, and Secretary Jai Bhatnagar led the rally.

Before this, in two sessions of the convention, it was decided that to establish the leadership and political dialogue of Kayasthas in the country on 23 September 2023, there would be a show of strength through a grand rally. Global President of GKC, Rajeev Ranjan Prasad, said that this rally would be organized at Ramlila Maidan in Delhi and efforts will be made to send invitations to leaders sitting on high positions in the country's political leadership to participate in this rally. One lakh Kayasthas will be mobilized in the rally. With this, the convention was declared closed.

Kayastha is currently in an educated but unconscious state of himself. Kayastha's primary work, the administration, has been snatched from his hands and divided into different sections of society. As a result, Kayastha has moved away from his original work. Now he is looking for other ways to establish his place in society. This was stated by GKC's Global President Rajeev Ranjan Prasad at the national session of the Global Kayastha Conference. At the same time, former Deputy Prime Minister of Nepal Bimalendra Nidhi, who

was invited as the chief guest in the program, could not come to Udaipur due to his political commitments. Still, he wished for the upliftment of Kayasthas through his video message.

Addressing the program, Dr. BP Bhatnagar, former vice-chancellor of JNU, said there is a lack of social and organizational unity to re-establish politically, so political parties do not see our numbers in voters we are not an electoral force. Understanding the power of each of our votes, we must unite in an organized manner. Along with this, people working in this field will have to cooperate from time to time for political awakening in our society.

As special guest of the program, LN Mathur, said that business or entrepreneurship is the most significant weakness of Kayastha. Its presence in this area is negligible. He is competent as a service provider but still weak in running an enterprise. If I see in the country, then Kayastha will be found in the most prominent position in the private sector, but it is rarely seen that he has his own business. As businessmen, we cannot take any name even if we want to take it. For this, we also have to find those areas commercially which can work as service providers. While addressing the program, Manikyalal Verma's granddaughter Chayanika Verma said that Kayasthas should try to make their identity instead of different sub-castes so that our numbers can be seen. Dr. Maheep Bhatnagar, the special guest of the Science College, who came to the program, said that those working in politics, who themselves do not want to stand with their society, should also prepare them to stand with the community. For this, let us join hands with them as a political force and work for the political future of society by going beyond the party organization. Earlier, the Global General Secretary of the organization, Anurag Saxena, presented the convention's role. At the same time, the program was conducted by District President Dr. Saroj Kumar.

### 17-day Khadi and Village Industries Exhibition begins

**Udaipur:** Under the joint aegis of Rajasthan Khadi and Village Industries Board, Jaipur and District Industry and Commerce Center, Udaipur, the 17-day divisional level Khadi Village Industries Exhibition 2022, which will run from December 17 to January 2, started in the Town hall premises from today. The exhibition was inaugurated by Divisional Commissioner Rajendra Kumar Bhatt, member of Rajasthan Scheduled Tribes commission, Laxshminarayan Pandya, and Pankaj Sharma, coordinator of Mahatma Gandhi Darshan Samiti, by opening the molly. While presiding over the inauguration ceremony on this occasion, Divisional Rajendra Bhatt said that Khadi had played an essential role in the freedom movement, and since that time, Khadi is still running as an idea. is necessary for the Khadi units to make their products accessible to the general public. Which innovations are needed now?

Laxshminarayan Pandya, a member of the Rajasthan Scheduled Tribes commission, said that in the changing fashion, the need for innovation in Khadi has been understood by Some organizations that they have adopted innovations. However, there is a need for a broader vision, technical support, and improvement. The institutions will have to come forward to find solutions to the problems being faced by the Khadi institutions. Convenor of Mahatma Gandhi Darshan Samiti Pankaj Sharma said that Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot had supported Khadi organizations above politics. Initially, the Exhibition Coordinator and Divisional Officer of Khadi Village Industries, Gulab Singh Garasia, said that this time a total of 105 stalls of Khadi and Village Industries units from different corners of the country had been put up in the exhibition.
