Treatment of esophageal cancer with advanced VAT technique under Chief Minister Chiranjeevi Yojana

Udaipur: Geetanjali Hospital is a hospital with all facilities. The patients coming here are treated using state-of-the-art techniques. Recently, a 45-year-old female patient with esophageal cancer was given a healthy life at Geetanjali Cancer Center.

Doctors in the Tumor Board of Geetanjali Cancer Center advised the patient and his family to undergo surgery. Since the patient's weight was only 25 kg, it was a big challenge to operate on the patient.

After this, the patient's treatment was started with chemotherapy and radiation. Seeing the improvement in the condition of the patient, the doctors decided to operate.

Dr. Ashish Jakhethia said that the patient was brought to Geetanjali Hospital in a frail condition due to difficulty in eating. Looking at the patient's condition, the patient was advised to undergo an endoscopy and abdominal C.T. scan.

The patient's operation lasted for about 7 hours. This type of surgery has been done continuously by the experienced team for the last four years at Geetanjali Cancer Center.



now the patient is in good health. 7 days after the operation, the patient can now eat food and has been discharged from the hospital.

Dr. Ashish said that esophageal cancer cases are continuously increasing in this belt. There are many reasons for this. Since this cancer is an aggressive malignancy, which is very difficult to treat, after a

thorough discussion with the multidisciplinary team of such patients, chemotherapy and radiation are first given to such patients, and after 6-8 weeks, The patient is operated upon, such patients face many problems after an open operation, in which the biggest problem that comes is pain, because if the tumor is taken out by opening the patient's chest, then the

patient will feel pain after the operation. One also has to face a lot of pain in the chest, due to which the patient does not get the health benefits quickly. For this, nowadays, VET (Video Assisted Thoracoscopic Surgery) is being done continuously by the experienced doctors of Geetanjali Cancer Center.

only three holes inside it, and keyhole surgery is done without making a big incision in the abdomen, and a new anastomosis of the throat is done. By operating in this way, the patient gets quick recovery, the next day after the operation, the patient comes out of the ICU and after about 6-7 days, the patient is discharged from the hospital.

All the responsible people of the City of Lakes and Rivers - City of Lakes and Rivers - will have to work together to make the Ayad river clean, healthy, eternal, and beautiful again. For this, restoration of the original environment and ecosystem of the river channel and the entire catchment area is essential.
