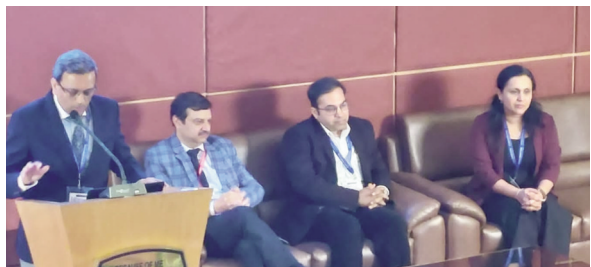
## Rajendra Marg School tops in skill model and seminar in vocational education
