Child in critical condition undergoes successful surgery at Pacific Hospital, **Umarda**

Udaipur: Doctors at Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS) Hospital, Umrda have successfully performed surgery on a girl who was in critical condition.

Chairman Ashish Agarwal said that Amaliya, a resident of Udaipur, brought a 03-year-old girl in critical condition to the family members of PIMS Hospital, Umrda. The girl had a disease called Pseudo-Pancreatic Cvst. This disease occurs in some patients after inflammation in the pancreas. A tumor filled with dirty water can take a severe form. The baby's tumor had taken a considerable size, and due to difficulty

breathing, there was a constant need for oxygen. After emergency treatment, the girl child was soon put for surgery, and a cysto-gastrostomy procedure was performed. The girl's health improved very quickly, and she was discharged in a completely healthy condi-



tion. The patient has been treated free of cost under the Chiranjeevi Health Insurance Scheme.

Pediatric surgeon Dr. Atul Mishra said this procedure was not as complicated as other operations in his department. Still, looking at the condition in which the baby girl came, it was a big success for him (pediatric surgery) and the pediatric medicine department

Udaipur: Department of Resource Management and Consumer Sciences organized sessions on RTI and Consumer awareness on authentication of weights and measures on the fourth day of the training program on "Consumer Empowerment through Rights and Legal Protection" in CCAS, MPUAT. Dr. Meenu Srivastava, Dean CCAS, MPUAT addressed the students and stressed on how consumers are experiencing fraud mainly on social media sites and almost one-third of Indian consumers have been victims of online fraud. Dr. Suman Singh introduced the speakers and highlighted that RTI can be used as an effective tool in demanding greater accountability on the part of the public and private authorities. In addition to that she also explained that correct weights and measures usage is needed if we want to have transparency in business practices.

The first speaker of the day, Mr. A. A. Chipa, Ex-Director, TRI, Udaipur elucidated that empowering the citizens to seek information under RTI is needed to maintain transparency, to check the large-scale corruption caused in the system and to escalate the awareness of the citizens regarding the governmental functions, Another speaker Mr. Ramaytar Poonia. Legal Metrology Officer, GoR, Rajasthan addressed the issue of consumer awareness on authentication of weights and measures and explained that standards of weights and measures ensures that the product or goods purchased are weighed correctly. Packaged commodities are also included under Legal Metrological department. He also added that Weights and measures offences are strictly punishable under IPC.
