Cattle breeders upset due to not getting allocation in **Devnarayan scheme**

Kota: on the instructions of the Autonomous Government Minister's intention to make Kota city free of stray cattle, UIT had prepared Devnarayan scheme for cattle rearers, for the vision with which Minister Shanti Dhariwal has made Devnaravan scheme for cattle rearers. all cattle rearers are Will be grateful for life. But many cattle herders of Kota city are still forced to go round the UIT for allocation there.

Making this allegation, Kiran Langdi, President of Devnarayan Awas Yojana Pashupalak Vikas Samiti, has accused UIT of misleading the cattle herders. In a conversation with journalists, President Kiran Langdi, Treasurer Shiva Bhak, Amra Kataria, Narayan Kalash, Govind Chad, Raju Khari, Devkaran Bhak, Ranglal Nekadi, Rukma Bai, Santosh Bai told that UIT is doing animal husbandry work at various places in Kota city. The cattle rearers were sent to the Devnarayan Yojana by saying that you go there, you will be allotted houses there. Even today around 50 cattle herders are spending time in other's houses, but UIT officials are not listening to them now. Not only this, there are 25-30 cattle rearers whose names are not there in the survey.

He told that the names of all these cattle herders are also registered in the survey conducted by UIT, initially application forms were given by UIT officials after taking 100 rupees from all of them, that too is present with them. After the completion of the scheme, when initially allotments were made to the cattle herders in the colony, at that time many cattle herders did not show interest in this scheme due to the cost of installments by UIT. Later on UIT reduced the amount of the installment, when

the cattle herders wanted to fill the allotment form there, UIT is now troubling them.
