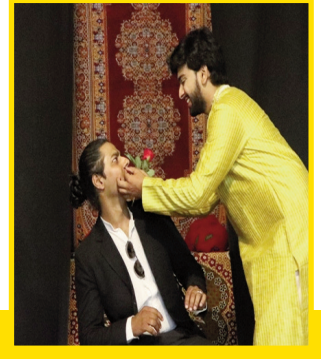

Road safety efforts brought international pride to Udaipur

Udaipur: To curb road accidents happening in Udaipur district headquarters and surrounding areas, on the initiative of Divisional Commissioner Rajendra Bhatt, under the joint auspices of District Administration, ICON Group Udaipur and Police, 'Save a Life' campaign was conducted from March 1 to 18. Has brought international glory to the district. This campaign to secure common life by making the city accident-free has found a place in the World Book of Records, London. On Monday, Dr. Jitendra Kumar

Taylia, Chairman of ICON Group, handed over the certificate issued by the World Book of Records to Divisional Commissioner Rajendra Bhatt and thanked him for the administrative support to make this campaign successful. On this occasion, Divisional Commissioner Bhatt said that being a tourist city, tourists from all over the country and the world visit Lake City, so if we can provide accident-free road transport facilities, it will be our most significant gift to the tourists. On this occasion, Dr. Taylia said that for the first time

in India, Divisional Commissioner Rajendra Bhatt and the local administration had received the honour of world record due to their active participation in the campaign related to public safety.

This is how the world record was made:

The certificate issued by the World Book of Records President and CEO Santosh Shukla states that under the 'Save a Life' road safety campaign run by the district administration and JCON Group (Ahmedabad) from March 1 to 18, 2023 in Udaipur city, Public



social participation with more than 3 million impressions on media has certified this campaign by being included in the World Book of Records London in Public Private Partnership.

It is noteworthy that given this campaign, Divisional Commissioner Rajendra Bhatt himself came down on the road to make the city accident-free and take stock of the activities of the movement, and by walking for about an hour, by removing haphazard parking and encroachments on the roadside, concerned for smooth traffic. Important

instructions were given to the officers.

During this, the institute expressed happiness in seeing the activities of lane management at the city's major intersections and smooth traffic due to this. In the campaign, the volunteers and traffic policemen advised and explained to keep two-wheelers in one lane and three-wheelers and four-wheelers in separate lanes.

They also encouraged the drivers who followed the traffic rules by giving them certificates.

Janata Sena will take out a mass dialogue tour from June 6, visiting 700 villages in 70 days

Udaipur: Janata Sena patron and former MLA Randhir Singh Bhinder told a press conference that the Congress government will not be formed in the state and will be limited to 25-30 seats. There he said that to listen to the grievances of the people troubled by this government, from June 6, we will go to every village with a yatra; the Jan Samvad Yatra will go to 700 villages for about 70 days. State Patron Mangilal Joshi, Bhinder Panchayat Samiti Pradhan Harisingh Sonigara, State General Secretary Paras Nagauri etc., were present during the press conference.

Janasamvad Yatra 2023 - Bhinder said that whether it is elections or public events, leaders go to villages and cities and go away after telling their views from the forums. But the public has to run to make their voice heard. That's why Janata Sena Rajasthan decided that a yatra should be taken out in Vallabhnagar Vidhansabha, where there could be direct communication with the common people. During the yatra, a planned preparation should be made to resolve the problems of the common people in their villages and areas and discuss various aspects with us, including the issue of not getting the benefits of government schemes. That's why we have named the Yatra Jan Samvad Yatra 2023. The yatra will start from Arnia village of Pithalpara panchayat of Vallabhnagar Vidhansabha on Tuesday, June 6. The yatra will last about 70 days, during which we will meet the common people by going to every village Dhani of the assembly.

In this journey, it has been decided to visit about 700 villages. Considering the convenience of the common people, they will reach the town every day from evening to night only to sit and communicate with the common people in the village platforms, temples and the courtyard of the house.

During the journey, if any person or family is facing difficulty in getting the benefits of government schemes or is facing problems in applying, we, on behalf



of Janata Sena, through E-Mitra, get such families or persons' applications made and help them. I will get the benefits of the schemes of the government.

Inflation relief, not disaster camp- The common people have not received any new relief from the dearth relief camps run by the present Congress government in the entire state. Only by calling people in the camps of the already ongoing schemes, printing a sticker and making a card they give certificates of being benefited. This government only wants to keep people busy with papers. From the yatra, we will also come to know that for the last four and a half years, how much the common people are getting worried and how the condition of the villages has been made.

Tree Plantation at reliance Chemotex



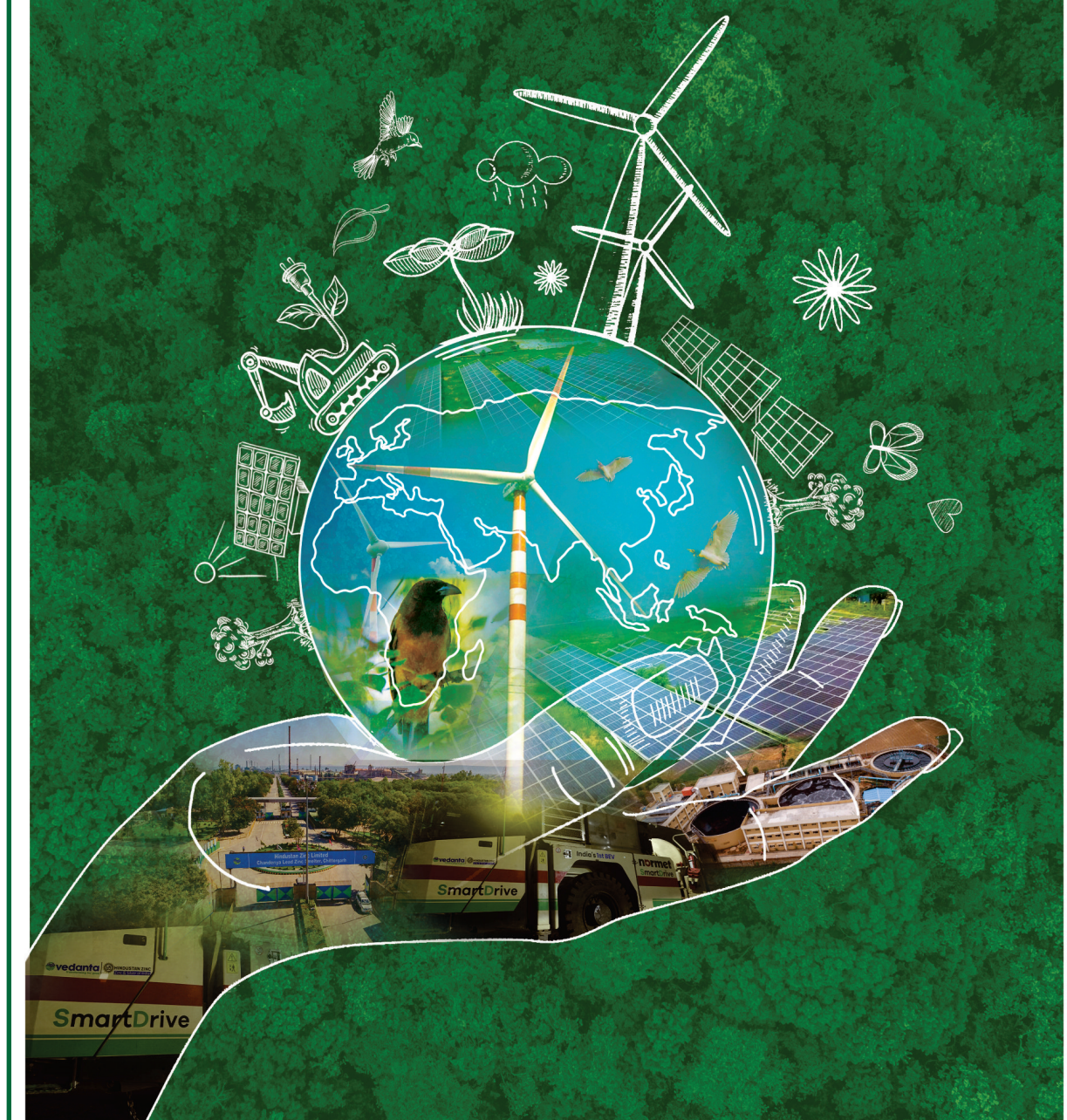

Urged for Veda-Science Research Center

Udaipur: Udaipur Citizen Society has requested Education Minister B.D. Kalla Citing Udaipur's fondness for Sanskrit since the time of kings and emperors must have Veda-Science Research Center

the Society asked the Education Minister that Udaipur, situated in the lap of nature, would also get the best environment for research from the perspective of the science of the Vedas.

President of Udaipur Citizen Society, Kshitij Kumbhat, in a meeting with the Education Minister at Circuit House on Tuesday morning, urged him that we have, SCERT, Rabindra Nath Tagore Medical College, There are institutions of national and international importance like Madan Mohan Malviya Ayurveda College, that Pratap University of Agriculture and Technology, Veda-Science Research Center will further strengthen Udaipur's status. He said that studying Vedas from the scientific perspective would pave the way for solving various life problems, not only in medical science. Students of medical science and Ayurveda in Udaipur will also benefit from this.

Sanskritist and former Principal of Nimbarka College Pt. Surendra Dwivedi said that today when Sanskrit is dominant all over the world, NASA has recognized the importance of Vedokta Gayatri Mantra, the usefulness of Sanskrit has been rendered in computers as well, in such a way Sanskrit language. The need for a research centre is also being felt to understand the ancient Indian texts Vedas-Puranas-Upanishads etc., from the scientific perspective. Mewar has also been fond of Sanskrit since the beginning, and the Maharana Sanskrit College outside Chandpole on the banks of Lake Pichola in Udaipur has been an example of this. Scholars from Banaras and Bihar used to come here to study and teach. With the establishment of the Veda-Science Research Center, the love for Sanskrit will increase again in Mewar. Udaipur's name will also be established on the world stage in Sanskrit.

Meanwhile, the members of the Society also met the Director of Sanskrit Education, Bhaskar Shrotriya and discussed with him the establishment of the Veda-Science Research Center in Udaipur. Dr. Umashankar Sharma, a senior member of the Society and former vice-chancellor of MPUAT, urged Shrotriya to make a plan from Ved Path shala to Research Center. Shrotriya also agreed to the Society's request and said that there is awareness about Sanskrit in Udaipur, and they will try to start the concept of the Veda-Science Research Center from Ved Pathshala.

Society's secretary Kamal Nahta said that social worker Ganpat Agarwal, society member Nilesh Karwan etc., were involved during the discussion with the Education Minister and Director of Sanskrit Education.
