THe third annual general meeting of the Rajasthan Export Promotion Council

The third annual general meeting of the Rajasthan Export Promotion Council was held at the Industry Building on Wednesday. The meeting was chaired by Chairman Shri Rajiv Arora. During the meeting, Chairman Shri Rajiv Arora provided information about the important

activities of the council. He mentioned that every possible assistance is being provided by the council to exporters to increase exports on the global stage. He informed that the process of establishing a world-class convention and exhibition center in Jodhpur has begun, which will ensure the successful organization of expos in the state. He also mentioned that in July 2023, the council played a successful role in providing a global platform to the state's exporters at the Indo-East Africa Trade Expo held in Nairobi, the capital of Kenya. He further stated that a State-level Export Helpline will be launched by October to provide exporters with all kinds of information.

Chairman Shri Rajiv Arora informed the board members that ongoing dialogue is being held with the Jaipur Development Authority for the allocation of land for the permanent building of the REPC. He also mentioned that officer employees would be recruited on a regular basis and through temporary hiring and contracts for working in the REPC. He highlighted that the successful implementation of the state government's industrial policies, export promotion programs, and campaigns has given momentum to exporters and exports in Rajasthan. Exports from Rajasthan were worth Rs. 46,476 crores in the year 2017-18, which has increased to Rs. 77,771 crores in the year 2022-23.

The meeting was attended by Additional Chief Secretary Smt. Veenu Gupta, Commissioner of Industries and Commerce Shri Sudhir Kumar Sharma, Secretary of the Agriculture Department Dr. Prithviraj, Commissioner of Rajasthan Foundation Shri Dheeraj Shrivastava, and Director of the Tourism Department Smt. Rashmi Sharma, among other board members and REPC

Udaipur: On the occasion of the 91st Diksha Jayanti of Tapasvi Samrat Keshulal Ji M.S., Keshavdham Seva Sansthan undertook a tree plantation drive at Omeshwar Mahadev, Haridas Ji Ki Magri, and Kedareswar Mahadev Undari in Udaipur. Swift Resolution of **Power and Water** Supply Issues in Kotda -Lakshminarayan Pandya

Udaipur: Lakshminarayan Pandya, a member of the Rajasthan Scheduled Tribes Advisory Council (TAC) and the Rajasthan government, undertook a tour of various villages in the Kotda region to assess various schemes and address the concerns of the local residents promptly

During his visit, members of the Block Congress Committee and community representatives highlighted the significant problems related to electricity and drinking water supply. Pandya immediately took action by engaging with officials from relevant departments.

Pandya shared that the current electricity supply to Kotda is hindered due to an overloaded power transformer at the Swaroopganj JSS (132 kV). To resolve this issue swiftly, a new power transformer, worth approximately 3 crore rupees, has been approved and will be installed within 20 days. This upgrade will double the capacity of the Swaroopganj JSS, alleviating the recurring problem of tripping caused by power overload in Kotda.

Pandya also revealed that the previous contract for upgrading the Swaroopganj JSS to 132 kV was terminated due to delays by the contractor. A fresh tender has been issued and as soon as the process is completed, work on this project will resume.

During his Kotda tour, Pandya received complaints from villages such as Nal Sandamariya and Umaria about the lack of electrification. He directed officials to initiate electrification projects in these villages immediately.

Addressing the drinking water issues in Kotda, Pandya instructed PHED (Public Health Engineering Department) officials to repair damaged pipelines within ten days to ensure regular water supply to the area.

During his visit, Pandya was accompanied by Block President Rajaram Kher, Kamalashankar Kher, Kesararam, Nagin Kumar, Gotamlal, Bhamaram, Kyum Khan, Sharada Devi, Narayan Lal, Dhuliram, and social worker Sarfaraz, along with Dinesh Odichch. This proactive approach by Lakshminarayan Pandya promises to bring swift relief to the residents of Kotda, resolving their power and water supply issues efficiently.
