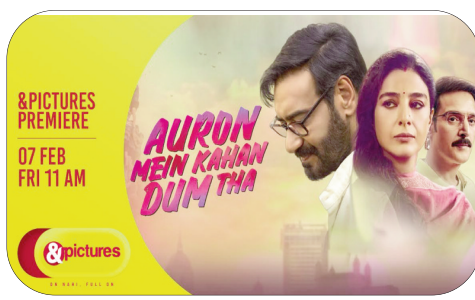
the Belvedere Club in Adani Shantigram Township, Ahmedabad, where Jeet Adani
